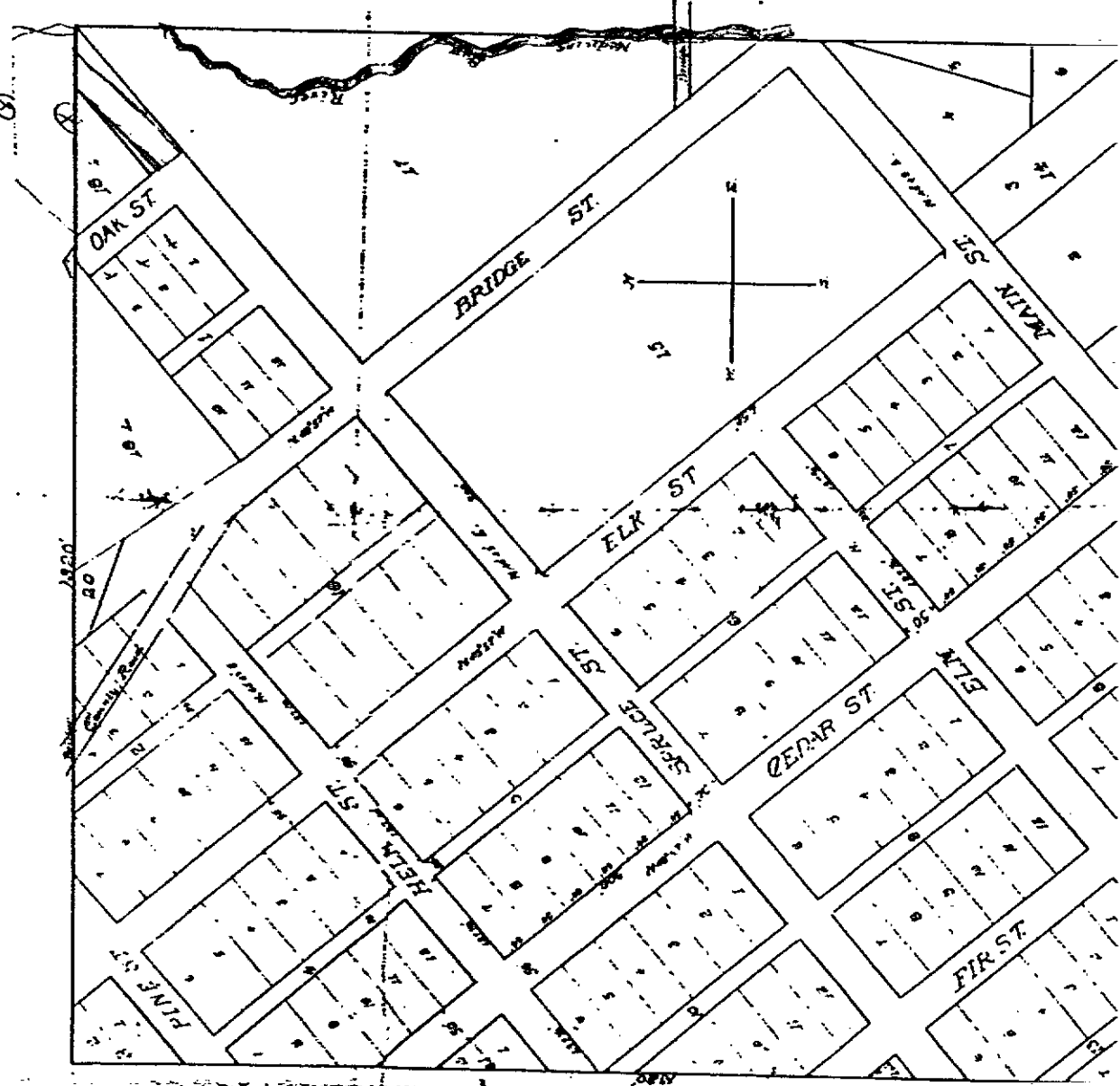


PLAT OF ELK MOUNTAIN

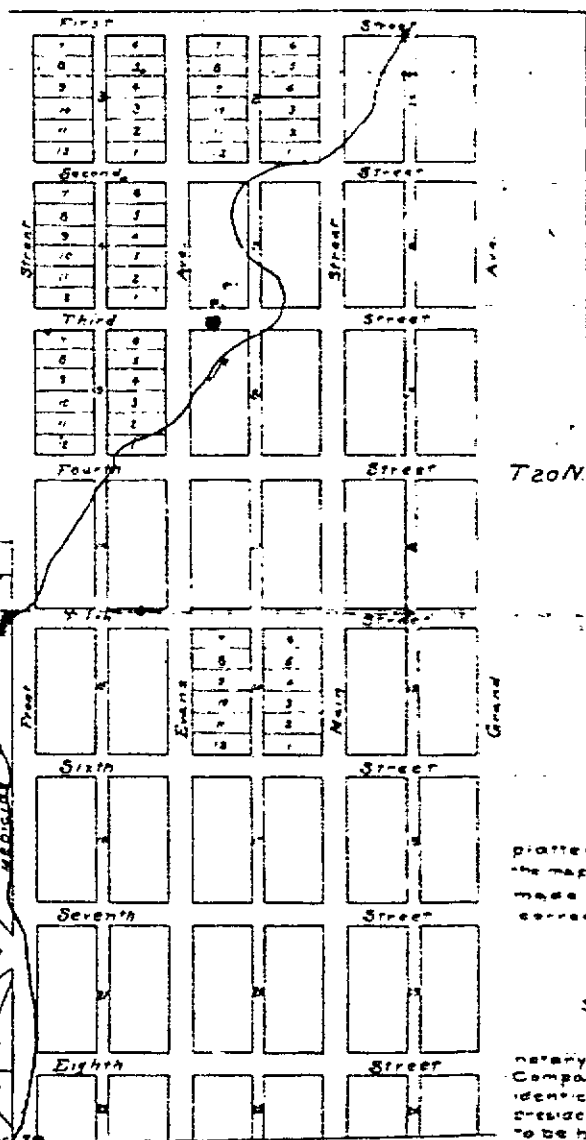


ELK MOUNTAIN CARBON COUNTY WYOMING
