

MAP OF SECOND PARK HILL ADDITION

TO
RAWLINS
CARBON COUNTY, WYOMING

Under Act of March 1, 1919, L. 1919, 175, Wyo.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That THE RAWLINS TOWNSITE COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Wyoming, being the sole owner and proprietor of the land shown on the annexed map and plat, and hereafter fully described, has laid out and platted, and by these presents does lay out and plat said land under the name of SECOND PARK HILL ADDITION TO RAWLINS, and does hereby dedicate to the use of the public all streets and alleys shown thereon, except such as are marked reserved. All streets sixty (60) feet wide to have a central roadway thirty six (36) feet wide, twelve (12) feet each side thereof to be used for sidewalk purposes, and all streets seventy (70) feet wide to have a central roadway forty (40) feet wide, with fifteen (15) feet on each side thereof to be used for sidewalk purposes.

Said Company further declares that the above and foregoing subdivision described by metes and bounds as follows: - Beginning at the northwest corner of Block 22, Park Hill Addition to Rawlins; thence south 2800 feet along the west line of Blocks 22, 15, 8, 7, 9, and 3, to the south line of Pine Street; thence west 326 feet; thence north 176.3 feet; thence N. 73°-27' E., 130.4 feet; thence north 2586.6 feet; thence east 201 feet to the place of beginning, as appears on this plat, excepting the strip of land 70 feet wide designated as the Lincoln Highway, situated in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, and NW 1/4 SW 1/4, of Sec. 17, T. 21 N., R. 87 W., of the 6th P.M., with the free consent, and in accordance with the desires of the undersigned, The Rawlins Townsite Company, the owner and proprietor thereof.

In witness whereof the said THE RAWLINS TOWNSITE COMPANY has, pursuant to a resolution of its Board of Directors duly adopted, caused these presents to be executed in its name by John C. Gallup, its President, and its corporate seal to be hereto affixed and attested by Herschel E. Dunlap, its Secretary, at Rawlins, Wyoming, this 6th day of March, 1919.
