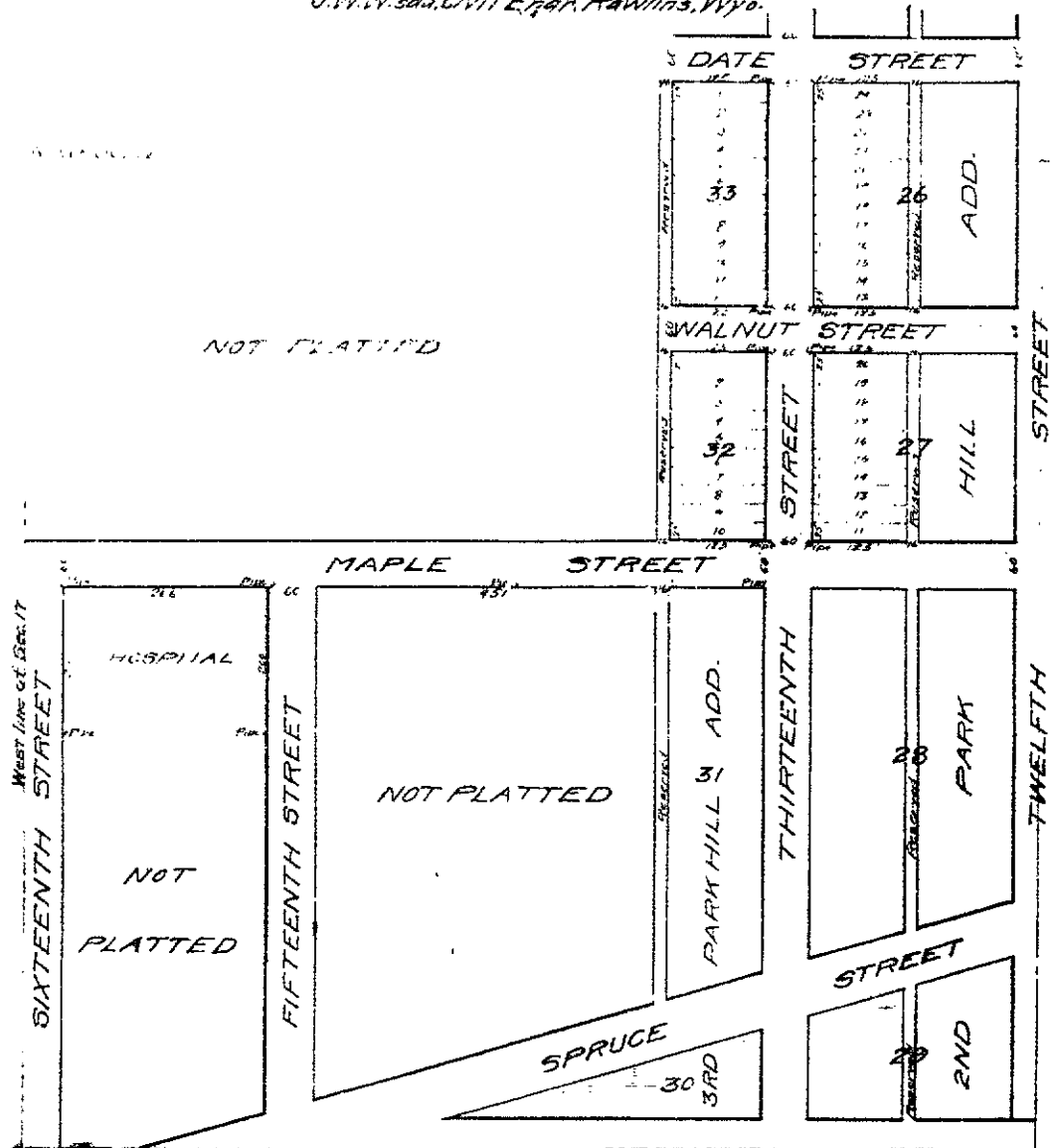


MAP OF FOURTH PARK HILL ADDITION

AND WHEREBY THESE PRESENTS

THAT THE RAWLINS TOWNSITE COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under, and by virtue of the laws of the State of Wyoming, being the sole owner and proprietor of the land shown on the annexed map and plat and hereafter fully described, has laid out and platted, and by these presents does lay out and platted land under the name of **FOURTH PARK HILL ADDITION TO RAWLINS**, and does hereby dedicate to the public all streets and alleys shown thereon, except such as are marked reserved. All streets sixty (60) feet to have a central roadway thirty (30) feet wide, fifteen (15) feet each side thereof to be used for sidewalk purposes, and 16th Street to have fifteen (15) feet on east side thereof for sidewalk purposes, remainder to be used for roadway.

Said Company further declares that the above and foregoing subdivision described by metes and bounds as follows: Beginning at the northeast corner of Block 28 Third Park Hill Addition to Rawlins, thence west along the south line of Maple Street produced westerly a distance of 777 feet; thence south to the North line of Spruce Street; thence westerly along said north line of Spruce Street a distance of 62 feet to a line which is parallel to and 60 feet distant from last named course; thence north to the South line of Maple Street produced; thence west along said South line of Maple Street produced a distance of 266 feet; thence South to the East and West center line of Sec. 17, T. 21 N., R. 87 W.; thence west along said center line to the West line of said Section 17; thence north along said West line of Section 17 to the North line of Maple Street produced westerly; thence east along said North line of Maple Street produced to a point 342 feet west of the southwest corner of Block 27 Second Park Hill Addition to Rawlins; thence north 670 feet to the North line of Date Street produced westerly; thence east along said North line of Date Street produced a distance of 326 feet; thence south a distance of 734 feet to the place of beginning, as appears on this plat is with the free consent and in accordance with the desires of the undersigned The Rawlins Townsite Company, the owner and proprietor thereof.
