KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

That THE RAWLINS TOWNSITE COMPANY a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Wyoming, being the sole owner and proprietor of the land shown on the annexed map and plat and hereafter fully described has laid out and platted, and by these presents does lay out and plat said land under the name of Sixth Park Hill Addition to Rawlins, being Blocks 37, 38, 39, and 40, and streets included in description, and does here-by dedicate to the use of the public all streets and alleys shown thereon except such as are marked "reserved". Fifteenth Street, and Gallup Place shall have central roadways thirty (30) feet wide, fifteen feet each side thereof to be used for sidewalk purposes, Pine, and Sixteen-th Streets are forty (40) and fifty five (55) feet wide respectively, and fifteen (15) feet of each adjacent to Blocks 39, and 40 shall be used for sidewalk purposes.

Said Company further declares that the above and foregoing subdivision described by metes and bounds as follows:— Beginning at a point on the South line of Maple Street 16 feet west of the Northwest corner of Block 37, Fifth Park Hill Addition; thence west along said South line of Maple Street a distance of 185 feet; thence South a distance of 200 feet; thence West a distance of 381 feet to the West line of Sec. 17, T. 21N., R. 67; thence south along said West line of said Sec. 17 a distance of 550 feet; thence east to the intersection with the northerly line, produced, of Spruce Street; thence easterly along the northerly line of Spruce Street to its intersection with a line parallel to and 15 feet west of the west line of Block 38 Fifth Park Hill Addition; thence north along said line parallel to and 15 feet west of the west line of said Blocks 37, and 38 to the place of beginning, as appears on this plat in with the free consent and in accordance with the desires of the undersigned THE RAWLINS TOWNSITE COMPANY the owner and proprietor thereof.
