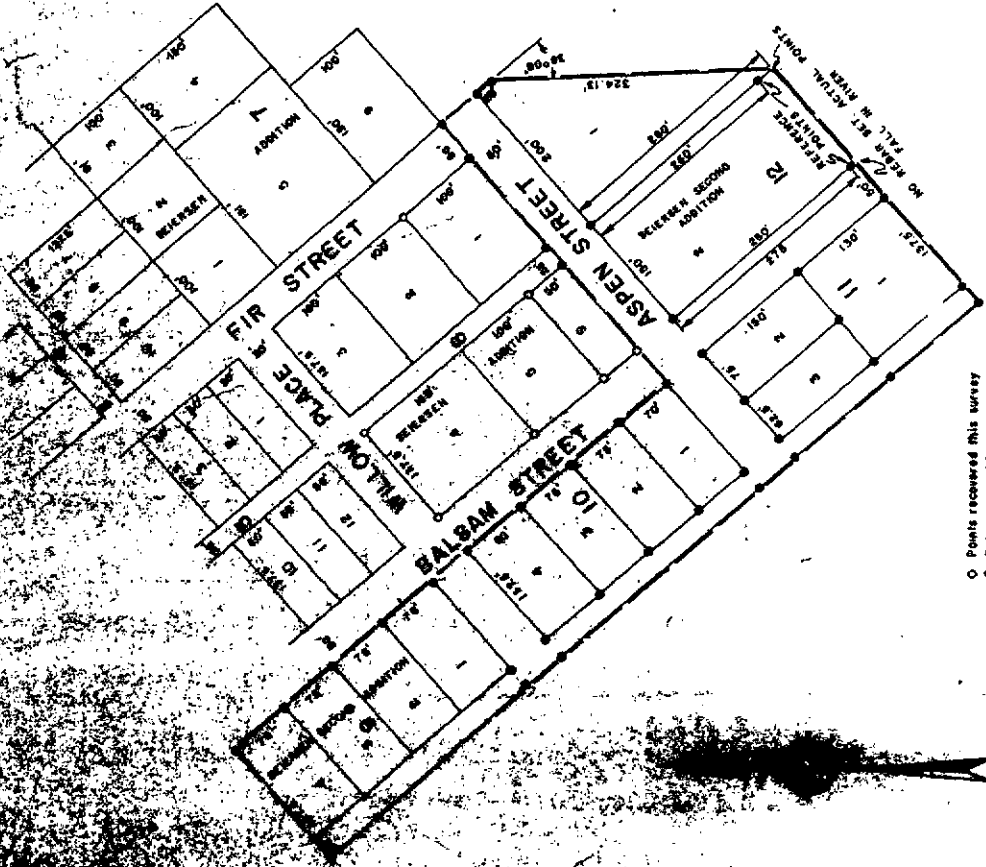




**SEIERSEN SECOND ADDITION
TO THE TOWN OF
ELK MOUNTAIN,
CARBON COUNTY, WYOMING**



DEDICATION

Know All Men By These Presents: That Soren Seiersen, Lena O. Seiersen, Robert Johnson, Victoria Johnson, R. A. Hakala, Edvard W. McNamara, Blanche McNamara and the State Highway Commission of Wyoming, the sole owners and proprietors of the real estate shown on this map and plat and hereafter fully described, have laid out and platted, and by these presents do lay out and plat the said real estate under the name of Seiersen Second Addition to the Town of Elk Mountain in the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, being Lots 1 to 3, both inclusive in Block 10, Lots 1 to 3, both inclusive in Block 11 and Lots 1 and 2 in Block 12 and the streets and alleys included in the description and they do hereby, designate in perpetuity to the use of the public all streets and alleys shown on this plat. The undersigned, Soren Seiersen, Lena O. Seiersen, Robert Johnson, Victoria Johnson, R. A. Hakala, Edvard W. McNamara, Blanche McNamara and the State Highway Commission of Wyoming, certify and further declare that the foregoing Addition is described as follows:

A tract of land in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) of Section 29, Township 20 North, Range 80 West, of the 6th Principal Meridian, Carbon County, Wyoming, described as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of the Seiersen Addition to the Town of Elk Mountain, said point being the intersection of the northwesterly line of Willow Place and the southwesterly line of Balsam Street, thence southwesterly along the southwesterly line of the Seiersen Addition, said line being the southwesterly line of Balsam Street, a distance of 350.0 feet, thence at right angles in a northwesterly direction along the southwesterly boundary of the Seiersen Addition a distance of 400.0 feet to a point in the northwesterly line of Fir Street, thence at right angles in a northwesterly direction along the northwesterly line of Fir Street extended, a distance of 750.0 feet, thence in a southwesterly direction along the westerly line of the alley of Block 10, Seiersen Addition extended southwesterly 330.0 feet, thence at right angles in a northwesterly direction along a line parallel to and 162.5 feet southwesterly of the southwesterly line of Balsam Street a distance of 860.0 feet, thence at right angles in a northwesterly direction parallel to the northwesterly line of Willow Place extended, a distance of 162.5 feet, thence southwesterly along the southwesterly line of Balsam Street, a distance of 300.0 feet to the point of beginning, containing 6.101 acres more or less, as appears on this plat and map, and that the above and foregoing described Addition is platted and laid out with the free consent and in accordance with the desires of the undersigned owners and proprietors.
