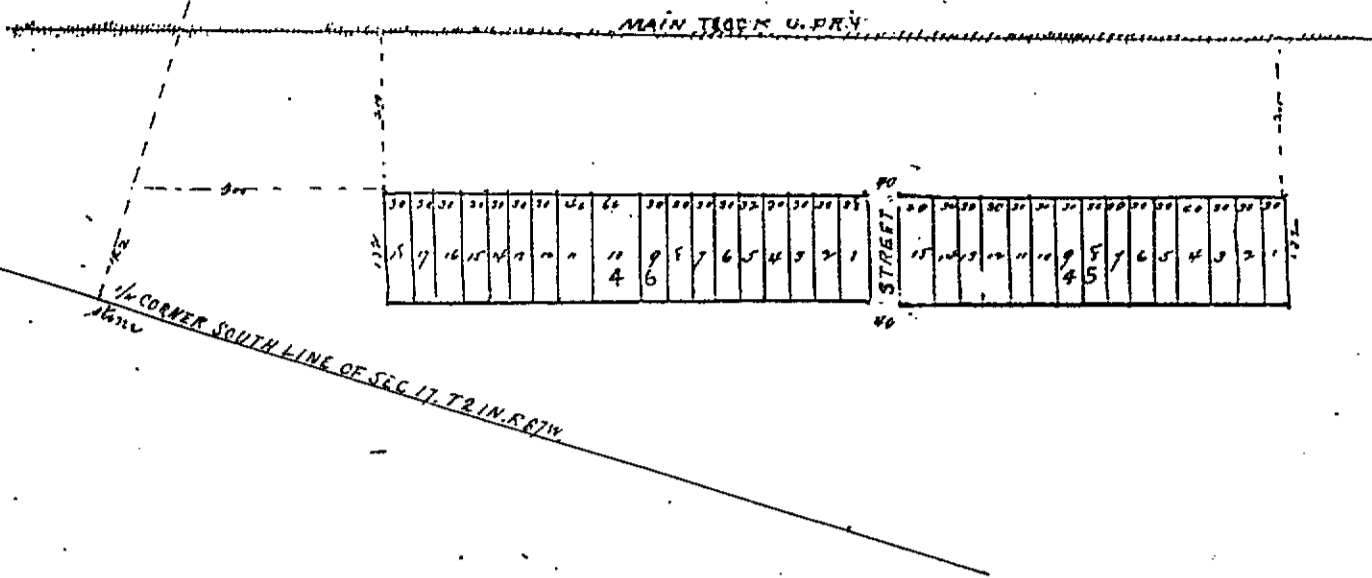


FOURTH ADDITION TO

The Union Pacific Railway Company being the original owner and proprietor of the land shown on this plat, and having heretofore subdivided and laid out thereon in towns named Fourth Addition to Rawlins, and having caused the same to be surveyed and staked into lots, blocks, and streets and a plat thereof to be made with reference to known monuments accurately describing all the subdivisions of said tract, numbering the same by progressive numbers and giving the dimensions and length and breadth thereof, and the breadth of street therein, do hereby state and make known that the said subdivision of the above described as appears on the accompanying plat is with the free consent and in accordance with the desire of the said Union Pacific Railway Company owner and proprietor as aforesaid, and that the said street is hereby dedicated perpetually to the public use.
