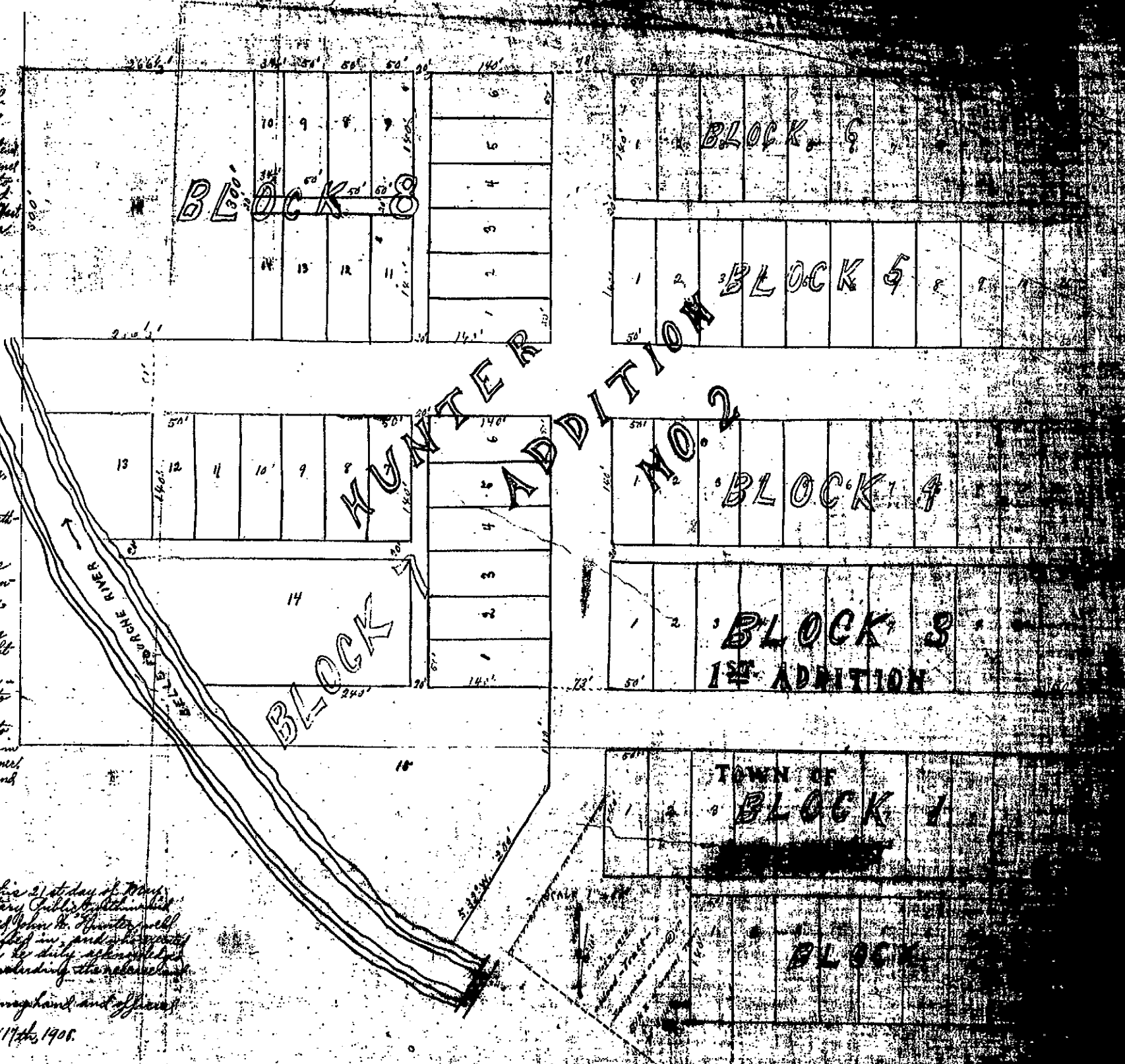

Hunter, were present at the following place, to-wit: the place of beginning of the town of Juliette, Wyoming, and there, in the presence of the said John H. Hunter, and the accompanying plat, a copy of which is attached hereto, and in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of Wyoming, do hereby certify that the said town of Juliette, Wyoming, is located as shown by the hereto attached plat, and more particularly described as follows:



Section 3
to the town of Juliette, Wyoming.

This certifies that John H. Hunter, an owner, has the owner in fact that the South East quarter (12) in Township 15 North, Range 12 East, Section 34, T15N R12E S34, as shown by the hereto attached plat, and more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the south-east corner of the North East quarter (12) of section twelve (12), thence North 52 feet, thence West 34 feet to place of beginning of section 34, thence North 52 feet, thence West 174 feet, thence South 370 feet to river. Return to place of beginning of said section 34, thence West 623 feet, thence South 270 feet, thence West 32 feet to river, containing Block Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7) and Eight (8) as shown on the plat hereto attached.

That the streets, alleys and avenues indicated on said plat are hereby dedicated to the public use.
The above and foregoing and the plat hereto attached are executed with the free consent and in accordance with the wishes of the undersigned owner.
