

Third Addition to Moorcroft, Crook County, Wyoming.

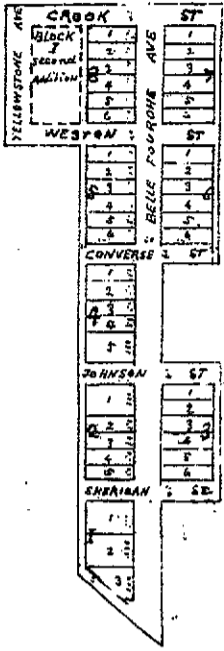
I hereby certify that on the 3rd day of November 1910 I surveyed the Third Addition to the Town of Moorcroft, situated on a part of the N.W. of section six (6) Township forty nine (49) North, Range sixty seven (67) West, and a part of the S.W. of section thirty one (31) Township fifty (50) North, Range sixty seven (67) West of the sixth (6th) Principal Meridian, which is clearly shown by reference to the plat of Moorcroft filed for record May 6th 1901.

The streets of the Third Addition are extensions of those of the same name in the town of Moorcroft and the additions thereto.

Public Township Avenue is parallel to Public Home Avenue of the second addition. Corner oak stakes are driven at the front corners of each lot.

The widths of the streets, avenues and alleys, and the dimensions of lots are indicated in feet by red figures on the foregoing plat, which is a correct delineation of said survey drawn to a scale of 250 feet to an inch. Each lot and block bears its own number.

Situate in the county of Crook, State of Wyoming, upon which the Third Addition to Moorcroft is located as shown by the foregoing plat and surveyor's certificate, except lot one (1) of Block Four (4), which was conveyed to the Trustees of the Presbyterian Church of Moorcroft, Crook County Wyoming, by deed dated September 10th 1909, also lot five (5) of Block Four (4) which was conveyed to Fannie L. Berry, by deed dated April 13th 1907, and lot one (1) of Block two (2), which was conveyed to P. H. Fisher by deed dated September 25th 1908.

That said owner has caused said lands to be surveyed and platted as said Third Addition to Moorcroft as shown by the foregoing plat and surveyor's Certificate.

That the streets, avenues and alleys indicated on said plat and mentioned in said surveyor's Certificate are hereby dedicated to the public use.
