CERTIFICATE OF SURVEYOR

I, FRED W BLATT, of Sundance, Wyoming, hereby certify that during the month of April, 1918, I surveyed the FOURTH ADDITION to the Town of Moorcroft, situated on parts of Section SIX, (6) Township FORTY-NINE (49) North, Range SIXTY-SEVEN (67) West, and Section THIRTY-ONE, (31) Township FIFTY (50) North, Range SIXTY-SEVEN (67) West, SIXTH (6) PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN as shown on this map, which is a correct delineation of said survey drawn to a scale of 250 feet to an inch. The Streets and Avenues are extensions of those of the same name in the Original Town and the FIRST, SECOND and THIRD Additions thereto, except Campbell Street which is parallel to Crook Street of the Second Addition, and Little Horn Avenue which is parallel to Belle Fourche Avenue of the THIRD Addition to the Town. Cedar stakes are driven well into the ground at the front corners of each lot. The width of the Streets, Avenues and Alleys, and the dimensions of the lots are indicated in feet and decimals on the plat. Each lot and block bears its own number.

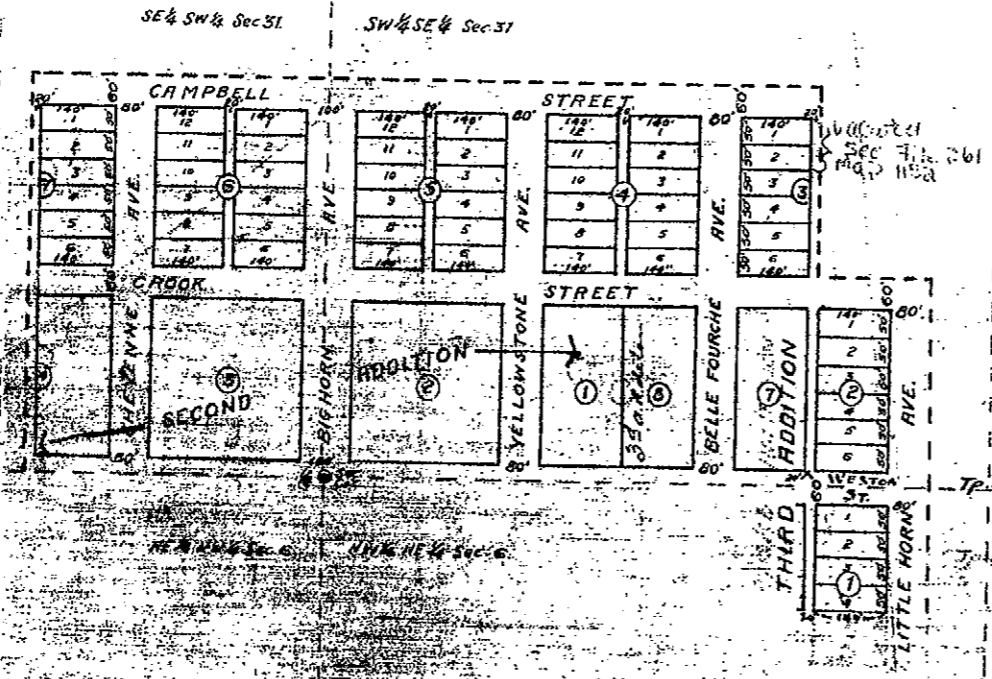
