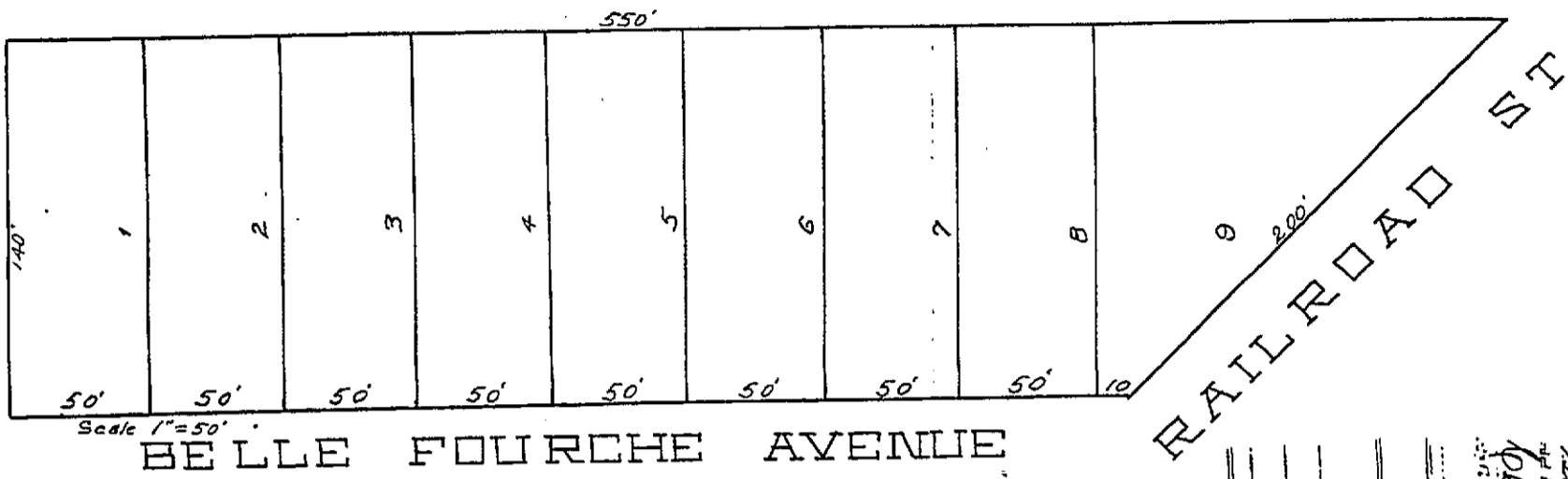


**SUB-DIVISION BLOCK N^o 1.

I, C. Russell, hereby certify that on January 8, AD 1925 I surveyed and subdivided the tract of land situated in the town of the City of Moorcroft, Wyoming, described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the continuation east of the south line of Sheridan Street of the town of Moorcroft, according to the plat which is recorded in Book One (1) of Plats, at page Thirty-three (33) of the Records of Crook County, Wyoming, which point is Three hundred eighty (380) feet East of the North West corner of Block number Seven (7) of said town; thence, South at right angles to said Sheridan Street, Four hundred ten (410) feet, more or less to a point One hundred eighty (180) feet distant at right angles and northwesterly from the center line of the main tract of the Chicago, Burlington and Quincy Railroad; thence Southeasterly, parallel with said center line, Two hundred (200) feet, more or less, to a point five hundred twenty (520) feet East of the east line of Yellowstone Avenue of said town extended; thence North at right angles to said Sheridan Street, Five hundred fifty (550) feet, more or less to a point in a line with the south line of said Sheridan Street; thence west along said south line, One hundred forty (140) feet to the point of beginning.

And as recorded in Book Twenty-four (24) at page five hundred eightyone (581) of Deeds in the Office of County Clerk and Ex Officio Registrar of Deeds for Crook County, Wyoming.

Which tract shall be hereinafter known as Block One (1) Sixth Addition to the town of the City of Moorcroft, Crook County, Wyoming.

That in subdividing said tract I started at the North West corner of said tract, thence South or the west line of said tract, four hundred ten (410) feet; That oak or ash hubs are driven well into the ground at front corners of each lot; That the accompanying plat is a correct delineation of said survey; Each lot bears its own number.
