



**Dedication.**

State of Wyoming  
County of Crook

This is to certify that, whereas, at a meeting of the stockholders of the Sundance Land and Improvement Company held on the 16th day of June A.D. 1892, it was duly authorized to cause to be placed and dedicated the following land, bounded and described as follows to wit: Commencing at a point 5 7/8 feet due north of the center of Sec. 13, T. 20 N., R. 23 W. of the 6th P.M. thence continuing due north to the west corner of the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of said Sec. 13, thence due east to the NE corner of the SW 1/4 of said Sec. 13, thence due south to a point 5 7/8 feet due north of the center of the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of said Sec. 13, thence due west to the place of beginning, said corporation being the owner and proprietor of said land and premises.

And whereas, in accordance with the said authority, the trustees of said corporation at a meeting held on the 20th day of June A.D. 1892, resolved to dedicate the above described land as a public street to be known as the Pearl Street Addition, and duly constructed, the President and Secretary of said corporation to execute articles of dedication of said tract as a town site in the manner provided by law.

Therefore, The Sundance Land and Improvement Company a corporation duly organized and doing business under the laws of Wyoming, does hereby dedicate the above described land to be a public street and boulevard as follows to wit: Commencing at a point 5 7/8 feet north of the center of Sec. 13, T. 20 N., R. 23 W. of the 6th P.M. thence continuing due north to the west corner of the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of said Sec. 13, thence due east to the NE corner of the SW 1/4 of said Sec. 13, thence due south to a point 5 7/8 feet due north of the center of the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of said Sec. 13, thence due west to the place of beginning, said land being and being in the County of Crook and State of Wyoming as aforesaid to be known as the Pearl Street Addition of the town of Sundance in the local thereof to be one hundred (100) feet in width.

The above dedication of said tract of land as aforesaid is made in full compliance with the laws of Wyoming in accordance with the laws of the State of Wyoming and the laws of the United States, and the same is hereby certified to be true and correct by the President and Secretary of said corporation.
