

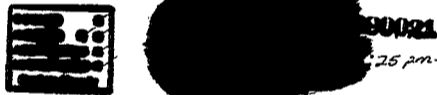
Surveyor's Certificate

I, Robert W. Taylor of 41/2 Engineering and Land Surveying of Torrington, Wyoming, do hereby certify that this plat of BLEDORN 6TH ADDITION was made from notes taken during an actual field survey made on February 18th, 1983 and that it correctly represents the lots, streets and alleys as marked on the ground by 1/2"x2" re-bars with aluminum caps marked P.L.S. Number 3891 and that the lands embraced in the Subdivision are that part of the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 10, Township 24 North, Range 61 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, Goshen County, Wyoming - More particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Point of Intersection of the South Boundary of East 18th Avenue and the East Boundary of East 1st Street, which point is monumented on the ground by a 1/2" x 2" re-bar with Aluminum Cap marked P.E.L.S. 677; Thence N89°49'45"E along the South Boundary of East 18th Avenue, a distance of 130.00 feet to a 1/2" x 2" re-bar with aluminum cap marked P.E.L.S. 677; Thence S00°32'45"W along a line that is parallel with the East Boundary of East 1st Street, a distance of 300.00 feet to the North Boundary of East 17th Avenue; thence S89°49'45"W along the North Boundary of East 17th Avenue, a distance of 130.00 feet to the East Boundary of East 1st Street, which point is monumented on the ground by a 1/2" x 2" re-bar with aluminum cap marked P.E.L.S. 3511; thence N00°32'45"E along the East Boundary of East 1st Street, a distance of 300.00 feet to the point of Beginning with all Bearings in this description being astronomically based on a Solar Observation made on the East Line of said Section 10 and with said parcel containing 0.90 Acres more or less.
