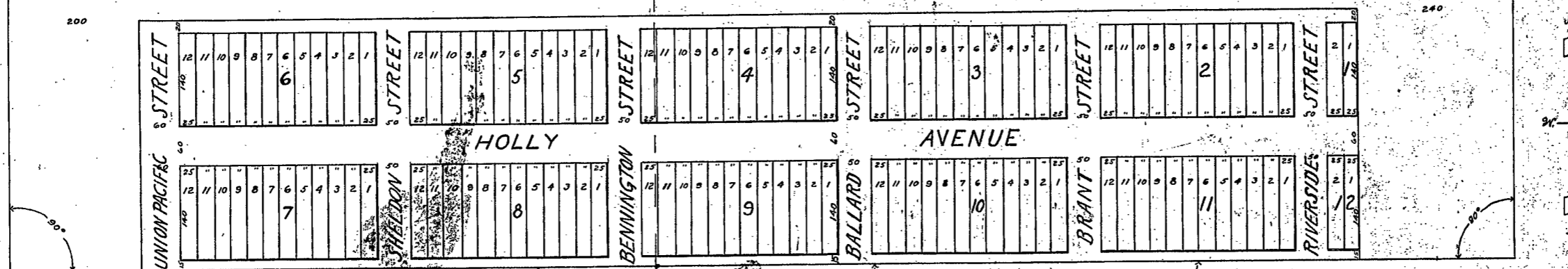


PLAT OF CANNON'S ADDITION TO TORRINGTON WYOMING

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE.

I hereby certify that in the month of June 1926, I surveyed CANNON'S ADDITION to the TOWN of TORRINGTON WYOMING, as appears on this plat and described in the accompanying dedication; said plat is a correct delineation of said survey drawn to a scale of 100 feet to an inch. HOLLY Avenue is laid out parallel to the line between the North one half and the South one half of the South one half of Section 15 Township 24 North, Range 61 West of the 6th Prim Meridian.

White pine stakes, 1 inch by 2 inches by 14 inches are driven well into the ground at the front corners of each lot. The widths of the streets, Avenues and Alleys and the dimensions of lots are indicated in feet on said plat. Each Lot and Block bears its own number.
