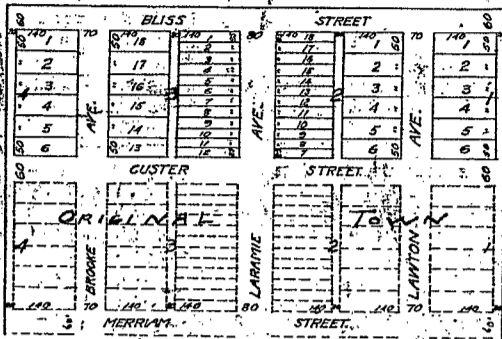


PLAT OF  
**THE FIRST ADDITION**

Thereby certify that on the 28 day of Dec 1912, I surveyed The First Addition to the town of Fort Laramie Wyoming situated in section 25 Township 26 North Range 64 West of the 6th R.M. Goshute County Wyoming, as shown by the annexed plat which is a correct delineation of said survey, drawn to a scale of 200 feet to an inch. The streets are continuations of those of the same name in the original Township. Bliss Streets are all parallel with Custer Street. Custer streets are drawn into the original street corners of each lot. The widths of streets and alleys and dimensions of lots are indicated in feet on said plat. Each lot and block bears its own number.
