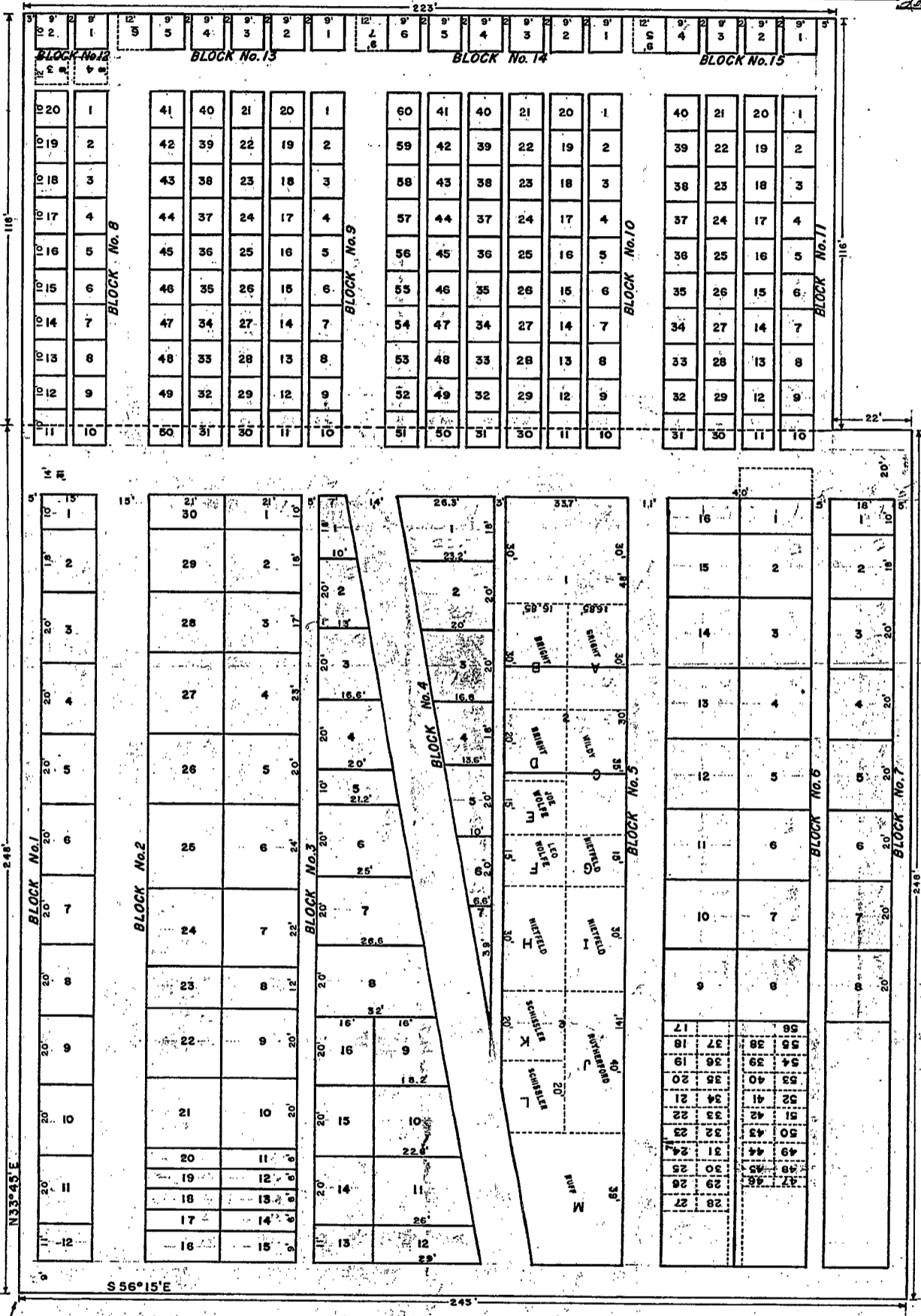

PLAT OF FT. LARAMIE CEMETERY

The duly elected Ft. Laramie Cemetery Board on June 29, 1962, handed me a linen tracing of the Original Ft. Laramie Cemetery prepared in August 1910 by Robert S. Grey, Surveyor, and a faded print showing the original Ft. Laramie Cemetery with additional Blocks and Lots (these additional Lots and Blocks I designate as the First Addition to the Ft. Laramie Cemetery) prepared in November 1928 by A.B. Reeves, Engineer-Surveyor, Wyoming License No. 107. The above mentioned Cemetery Board then instructed me to make this copy of the Reeves Plat. The print by A.B. Reeves has been marked over in ink and pencil by unknown persons and in some cases the dimensions on the Reeves print have been changed. Lots are shown in what Reeves designated as Streets, and cases are found where areas have been subdivided and given Lot numbers. These pencil and ink changes are shown on this map by dotted lines and the numbers can be read from the upper border or left border of this map.

Surveys performed under my personal supervision, indicate that the Ft. Laramie Cemetery as fenced and used does not match either the Grey or Reeves maps, which indicates that the surveys by these men were either ignored or obliterated. The results of my surveys have been reported on separate maps.
