SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I hereby certify that in the month of September 1919 I surveyed the town of Goshen Wyoming which is located in the West half of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of section 18 Township 21 North Range 61 West of the 6th P.M. containing twenty acres, more or less, according to the United States Government survey and the said townsite more particularly described to wit: Commencing at a point which is 200 rods West of the Northeast corner of the said section 18, thence South and parallel with the East line of said section 18 a distance of 80 rods, thence West and parallel with the North line of said section 18 a distance of 40 rods thence North and parallel with the East line of said section 18 a distance of 80 rods thence East 40 rods along the North line of said section 18 to the point of beginning. The widths of streets and alleys and the dimensions of lots are indicated in feet on the annexed plat which is a correct delineation of said survey drawn to a scale of 60 feet to an inch. 40d. spikes and 3/4 x 1 1/2 x 18 white pine stakes are driven at the exterior corners of each lot.

Each lot and block bears its own number.
