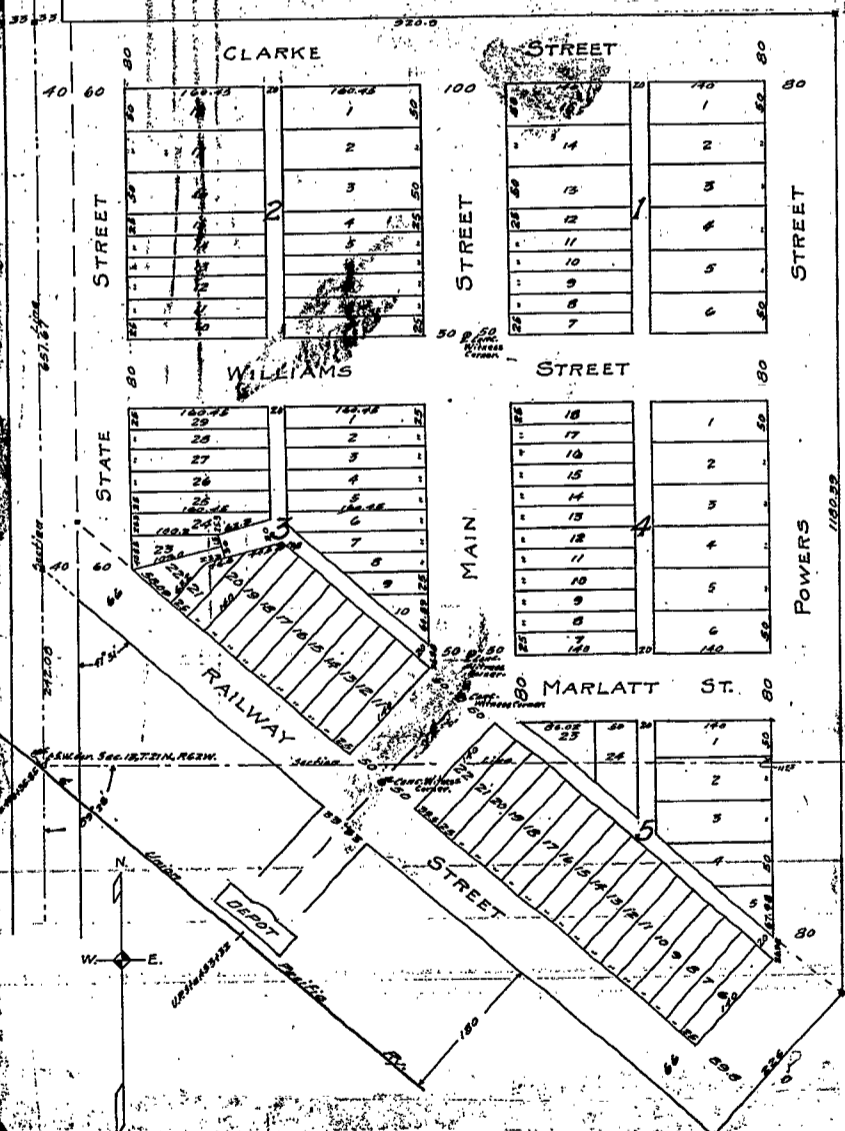


HAWK SPRINGS

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, J. G. Mangel, of Torrington, Wyoming, do hereby certify that this plat of the Original Town of **HAWKSPRING**, Wyoming, was made from notes taken during an actual survey, made under the direction of C. L. Huntley, for whose work I stand directly responsible. The survey was made the month of February 1928 and on the following described land, the Southwest Quarter of the west Quarter (SW 1/4) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Twenty-one (21) North, Range Sixty-two (62) West of the 6th P. M., Goshute County, Wyoming, as shown by the annexed plat, which is a continuation of said survey drawn to a scale of 100 feet to an inch and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the west line of said Section 13, 242.08 feet north of the southwest corner of said section and running thence north along said west line 351.07 feet, thence east and at right angles to said west line 220.3 feet; thence south and parallel to said west line 1180.39 feet to a point 406 feet distant from the center of the main line of the Union Pacific Railway; thence in a southerly direction and at right angles to said main line 225 feet to the north line of the right of way of the Union Pacific Railway Company and thence in a northerly direction along the north line of said right of way to the point of beginning. Final stakes 2" x 2" x 12" are driven well into the ground at the front corners of each lot. The widths of the streets and alleys and the dimensions of lots are indicated in feet and fractions thereon on said plat. Each lot and block bears its own number.
