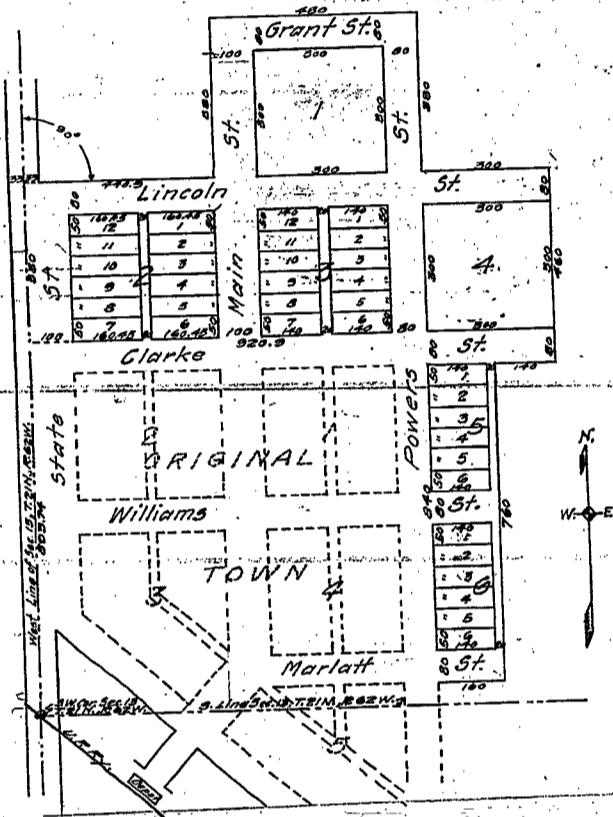


THE FIRST ADDITION TO HAWKSPRINGS, WYOMING.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

J. G. Harrel, of Torrington, Wyoming, do hereby certify that this plat of the First Addition to Hawksprings, Wyoming, was made from notes taken during an actual survey, made under my direction by C. L. Bentley, for whose work I stand directly responsible. The survey was made during the month of July, 1928, and on the following described land: the Southwest (SW) Quarter of Section Thirteen (13), Township Twenty-One (21) North, Range Sixty-two (62) West of the 5th E., Coshon County, Wyoming, as shown by the annexed plat which is a correct delineation of said survey drawn to a scale of 300 feet to an inch and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the west line of said section thirteen (13) 398.74 feet north of the southwest corner of said section and running thence north 530 feet, thence east 730 feet, thence south 350 feet, thence east and at right angles to said west line 440.9 feet, thence north and parallel to said west line 370 feet, thence south and parallel to said west line 480 feet, thence south and parallel to said west line 500 feet, thence south and parallel to said west line 490 feet, thence west and at right angles to said west line 130 feet, thence north and parallel to said west line 760 feet, thence west and at right angles to said west line 130 feet, thence north and parallel to said west line 840 feet and thence west along the north line of Clarke street in the original town of Hawksprings 120.3 feet to the point of beginning. Iron stakes are driven flush with the ground at the front corners of each lot. The widths of the streets and alleys and the dimensions of lots are indicated in feet and fractions thereof on said plat. Block and lot numbers are shown on said plat.
