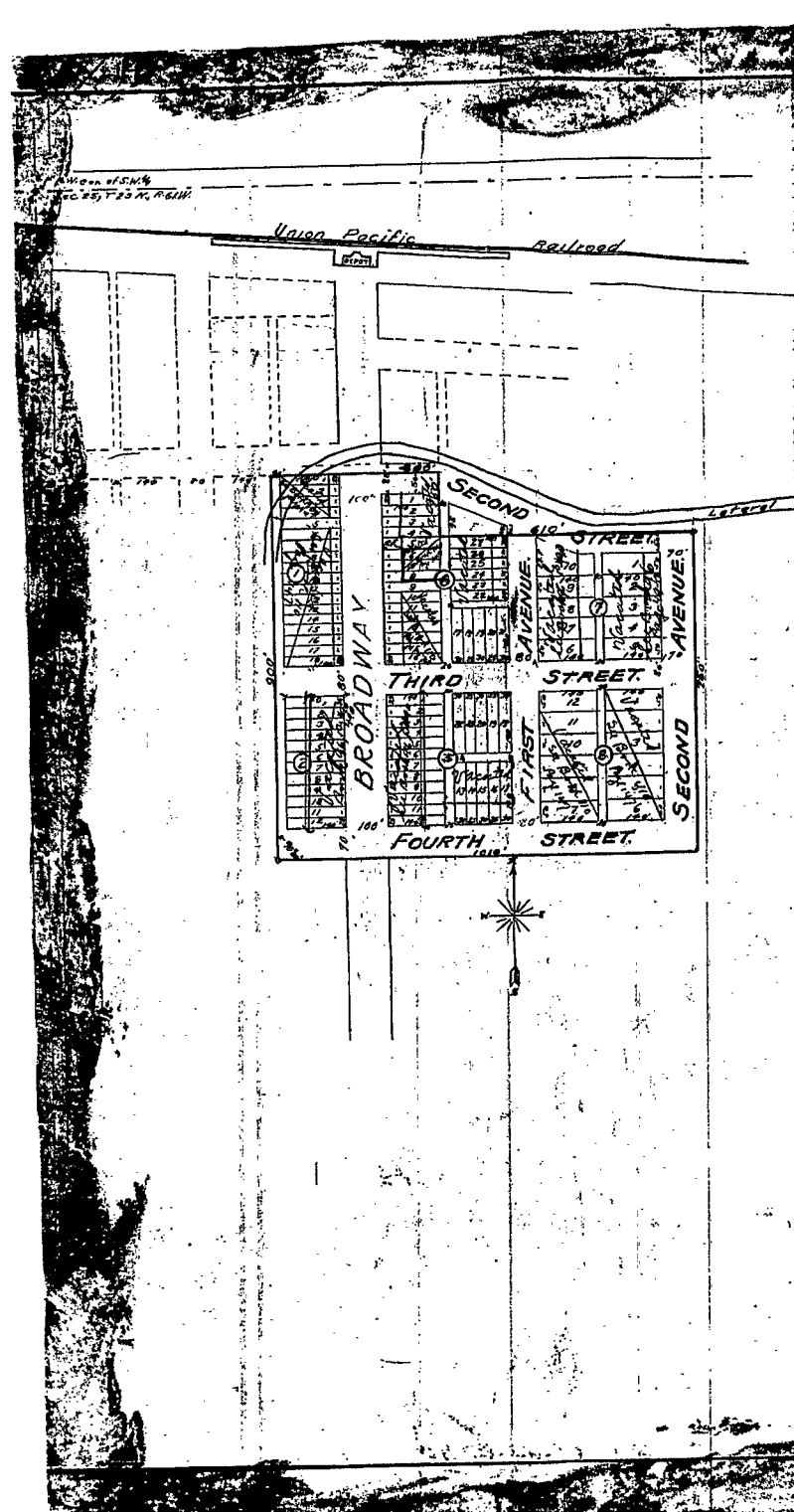


PLAT OF

SURVEYORS CERTIFICATE

I, J. G. Mangel, of Torrington, Wyoming do hereby certify that this plat of the Original Town of HUNTLEY, Goshen County, Wyoming was made from field notes of an actual survey made by W. T. Fox, under my direction, and I do hereby vouch for the correctness of the same. The survey was made in the month of September 1921 and on the following described land: — that portion of the S.W. 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 23 N. R. 61 W. of the 6th P.M., Goshen County, Wyoming as is shown on the annexed plat which is a correct delineation of said survey, drawn to a scale of 200 feet to an inch, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point which is 679 1/2 feet South and 553 feet East of the N.W. cor. of the S.W. 1/4 of said Sec. 25, thence East 400 feet, thence South for a distance of 180 feet, thence East for a distance of 630 feet, thence South for a distance of 750 feet, thence West for a distance of 1010 feet, thence North for a distance of 900 feet to the point of beginning. For the purpose of the above description the direction of the West line of said Sec. 25 is taken as north and south and east and west at right angles thereto. The Avenues are laid out parallel to the west line of the section and the Streets are laid out at right angles to the Avenues. Said survey is perpetuated on the ground by tying same to the North West corner of the South West quarter of Section 25, which is marked by a concrete monument in the form of a truncated pyramid having an eight inch square top, a twelve inch square and which is thirty inches in height and is buried flush with the ground. The quarter corners of said Sec. 25 are marked with similar monuments. White pine stakes 1 1/2 x 1 1/2 centered with a tack are driven well into the ground at the front corners of each lot. The widths of streets, avenues and alleys and the dimensions of the lots are indicated in feet on the annexed plat, and each lot and block bears its own number.
