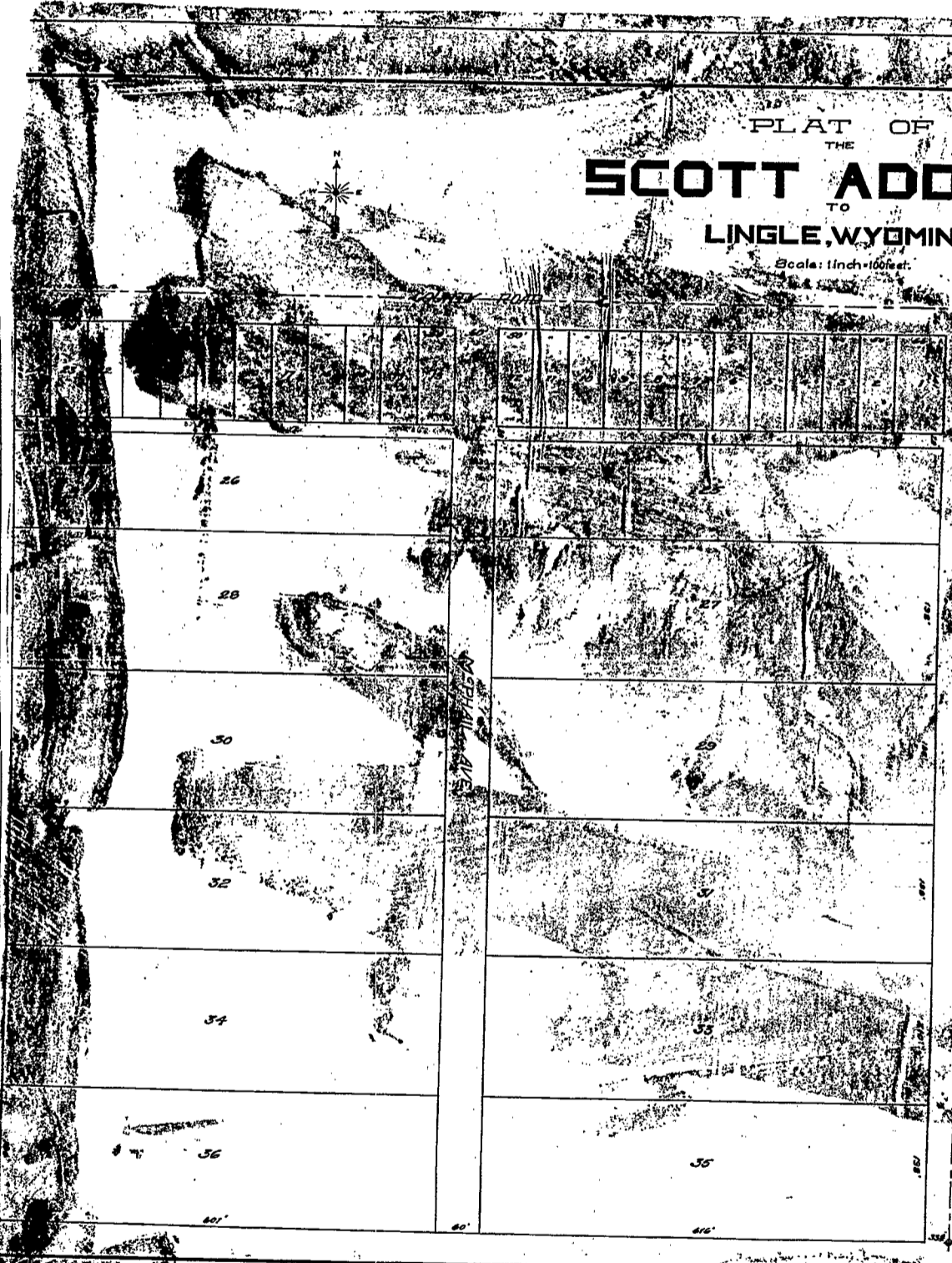


PLAT OF
