

**SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE.**

I, J.G. Marzel of Torrington, Wyoming do hereby certify that this plat of SPRINGER was made from field notes of an actual survey made by me on December 8<sup>th</sup> 1920 and that the town of SPRINGER is described as follows: That portion of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 36 and of the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 35 Township 23 North, Range 62 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Goshen County, Wyoming, as is shown on the annexed plat which is a correct delineation of said survey, drawn to a scale of 100 feet to an inch. The streets are laid out parallel to the adjacent subdivisional lines of the Sections, namely, the line between Sections 35 and 36 and between the NE 1/4 and the SE 1/4 of Section 35 and between the NW 1/4 and the SW 1/4 of Section 36 of said Township and Range. Said survey is perpetuated on the ground by being same to the 1/4 corner between said sections 35 and 36 which is marked by a concrete monument in the form of a truncated pyramid having an eight-inch square top, a twelve inch square base and which is thirty inches in height and is buried in the ground below the level of the traveled road. White pine stakes 1 1/2 x 1 1/2 centered with a tack are driven well into the ground at the front corners of each lot. The widths of the streets, avenues and alleys and the dimensions of the lots are indicated in feet on said plat and each lot and block bears its own number.
