

SURVEYORS CERTIFICATE

I, J. G. Marzel, Surveyor of Goshen County, Wyoming, do hereby certify that this plat of 1st ADDITION TO SPRINGER, GOSHEN COUNTY, WYOMING, was made of a valid plat of a survey made by Henry Springer and his wife Alice Springer for whose work I am personally responsible, and that the same is described as follows: That portion of the SW 1/4 of Section 36, Township 23 North, Range 62 West of the 6th P.M., Goshen County, Wyoming, as shown on the annexed plat which is a correct delineation of said survey, drawn to a scale of 150 feet to an inch. The streets are laid out parallel to the adjacent subdivisional lines of the section, namely, the line between sections 35 and 36 and the line between the NW 1/4 and the SW 1/4 of Section 36 of said Township and Range. Said survey is perpetuated on the ground by tying same to the 1/4 Section corner between Sections 35 and 36 which is marked by a concrete monument in the form of a truncated pyramid having an 8" square top, a 12" square base and which is 30" in height and is buried in the ground below the level of the traveled road. White pine stakes 1" x 1 1/2" x 14" centered with a tack are driven well into the ground at the front corners of each lot. The widths of streets, avenues and alleys and the dimensions of the lots are indicated in feet on said plat and each lot and block bears its own number.
