I hereby certify that on the 21st of April, 1900 I surveyed the town of Torrington situated on the central part of the S. 1/4 of Sec. 10 T. 21 N. R. 61 W. The N. 1/2 corner of said S. 1/4 is 25 feet N. and 145 feet W. of the S. 1/2 of said S. 1/4 Sec. 10. The corners and boundaries are laid out at right angles with the S. line of said S. 1/4 Sec. except along S. 1/2 Sec. 10. The stakes are driven, well into the ground at the four corners of each lot and also at the four corners of the platted area. The survey was made to a scale of 180 feet to an inch. The streets, avenues and dimensions of lots are shown in feet and decimals by red figures on the plat and black lines to show number.
