This certifies that the Lincoln Land Company is a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the state of Nebraska, is the owner in fee simple of that part of the south west quarter (SW 1/4) of section 10, Township 10 North, Range numbered Sixty one (61) West of the 10th Principal Meridian on which the First Addition to Torrington, consisting of blocks numbered One (1) through (4) inclusive, is located as is shown on the foregoing plat that said blocks numbered One (1) through (4) are the same blocks as were platted in the original town of Torrington and afterward a plat dated February 13th 1902 and recorded in Book of Plats on page 114.

These oak stakes are driven well into the ground at front corners of each lot, and stones are placed in the ground at the places indicated on the plat, each plat being a correct delineation of any of said blocks drawn to a scale of 180 feet to an inch. The width of the streets, avenues and alleys and dimensions of lots are indicated in feet and decimals by red figures on the plat. Each block bears its own number; that said one and one half acre land to be surveyed and platted as a First Addition to Torrington as shown on the foregoing plat. The survey in this addition is a continuation of the same name in the original plat and the streets, avenues and alleys located on said plat are hereby dedicated to the public use.

In testimony whereof, the said Lincoln Land Company has caused this instrument to be signed by its duly constituted secretary and the president of said company to be affixed, this first day of March 1905. Executed in duplicate.
