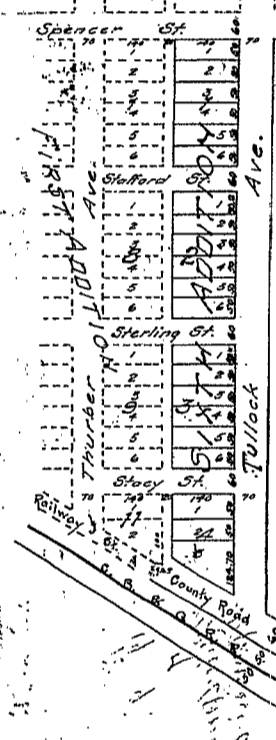


The Sixth Addition to Torrington, Wyoming
 Scale - 150 feet to an inch.



I hereby certify that in the month of June, 1919,
 The Sixth Addition to the town of Torrington,
 Wyoming, situated in Section 10, Township 24
 Range 8 West of the 6th P.M., Eastern Wyoming
 as shown by the annexed plat which is a continuation
 of said survey, drawn to a scale of 150 feet to an inch.
 The streets are continuations of those of the same
 name in the first and second additions. Cedar stakes
 are driven well into the ground at the four corners
 of each lot. The widths of streets and alleys and di-
 mensions of lots are indicated in feet on said plat.
 Each lot and block bears its own number.
