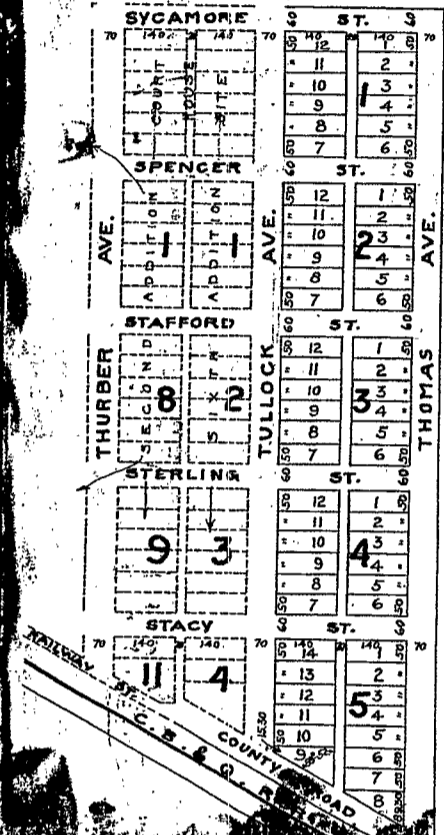


PLAT OF
The Seventh Addition
 TO TORRINGTON WYOMING.

I hereby certify that, in the month of Sept., 1919, I surveyed the Seventh Addition to the Town of Torrington Wyoming, situated in Section 10, Township 24 North, Range 61 West of the 6th P.M. Goshen County, Wyoming, as shown by the annexed plat which is a correct delineation of said survey, drawn to a scale of 200 feet to an inch. The streets are continuations of those of the same name in the first, second and sixth additions. Thomas Ave. is laid out parallel with Tullock Ave.

Cedar stakes are driven well into the ground at the front corners of each lot. The widths of streets and alleys and dimensions of lots are indicated in feet on said plat. Each lot and block bears its own number.
