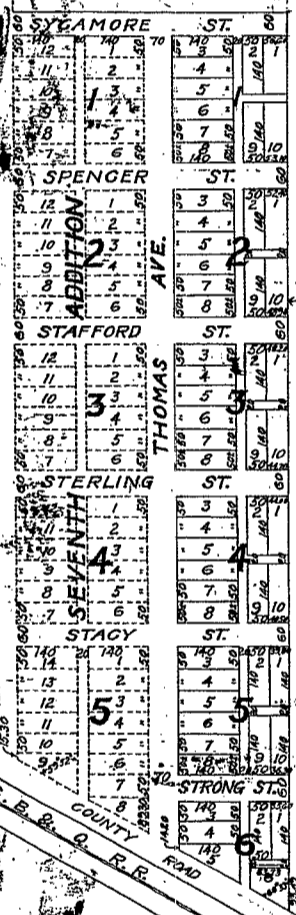

SURVEYORS CERTIFICATE

I hereby certify that, in the month of Feb'y, 1920, I surveyed The Eighth Addition to the town of Torrington Wyoming situated in Section 10, Township 24 North, Range 61 West of the 6th P.M. Goshute County, Wyoming as shown by the annexed plat which is a correct delineation of said survey drawn to a scale of 200 feet to an inch. The streets are continuations of those of the same name in the First, Second, Sixth and Seventh Additions. Strong Street is laid out parallel to Stacy Street. Cedar stakes were driven well into the ground at the front corners of each lot. The widths of streets and alleys and the dimensions of lots are indicated in feet and fractions there of on said plat. Each Lot and Block bears its own number.
