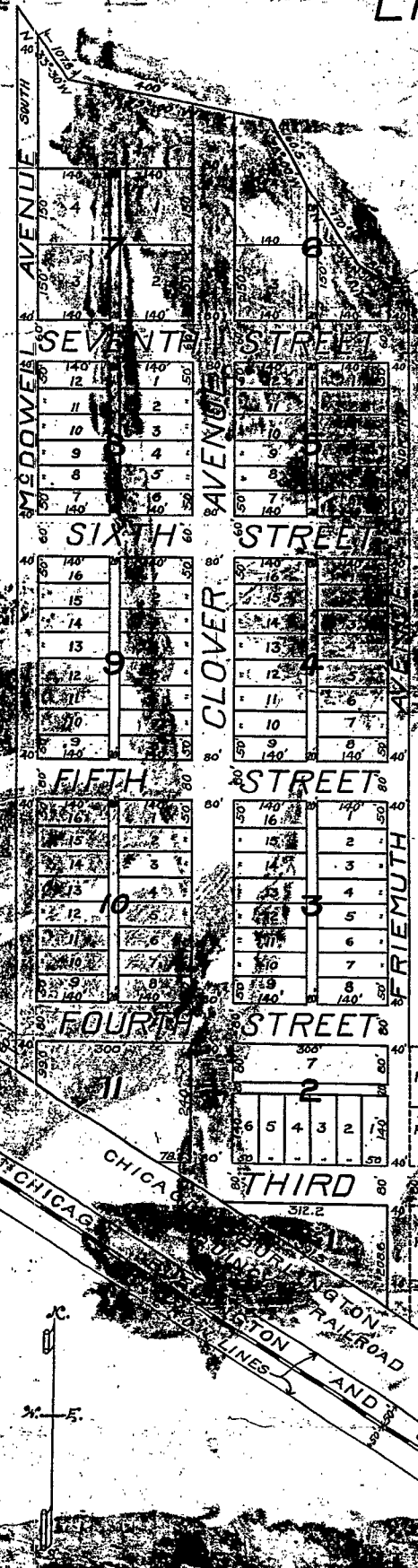


# WALKERS ADDITION LINGLE WYOMING



**SURVEYORS CERTIFICATE**

I hereby certify that in the month of April 1920, I checked the survey of the WALKERS ADDITION to the town of Lingle, Wyoming, made by W.J. Knowlton County Surveyor of Goshute County, Wyoming, and find that the same is situated in the East one half of Section 18, Township 25 North, Range 62 West of the 6th P.M. Goshute County, Wyoming, as shown on the annexed plat, which is a correct delineation of said survey drawn to a scale of 100 feet to an inch. The Avenues are laid out parallel to Main Street and the Avenues in the original town of Lingle. Third Street is a continuation of the street of the same name in the original town of Lingle and the other streets are laid out parallel to it. Very few stakes which were set by W.J. Knowlton marking the corners of the lots and blocks remain, having been destroyed when the town site was farmed; a few stakes however were found undisturbed and identified as the original stakes and the survey was checked from these. No new stakes whatever were set. The widths of the avenues, streets and alleys and the dimensions of the lots and blocks are indicated in feet and fractions thereof on the above mentioned plat. Each lot and block bears its own number.
