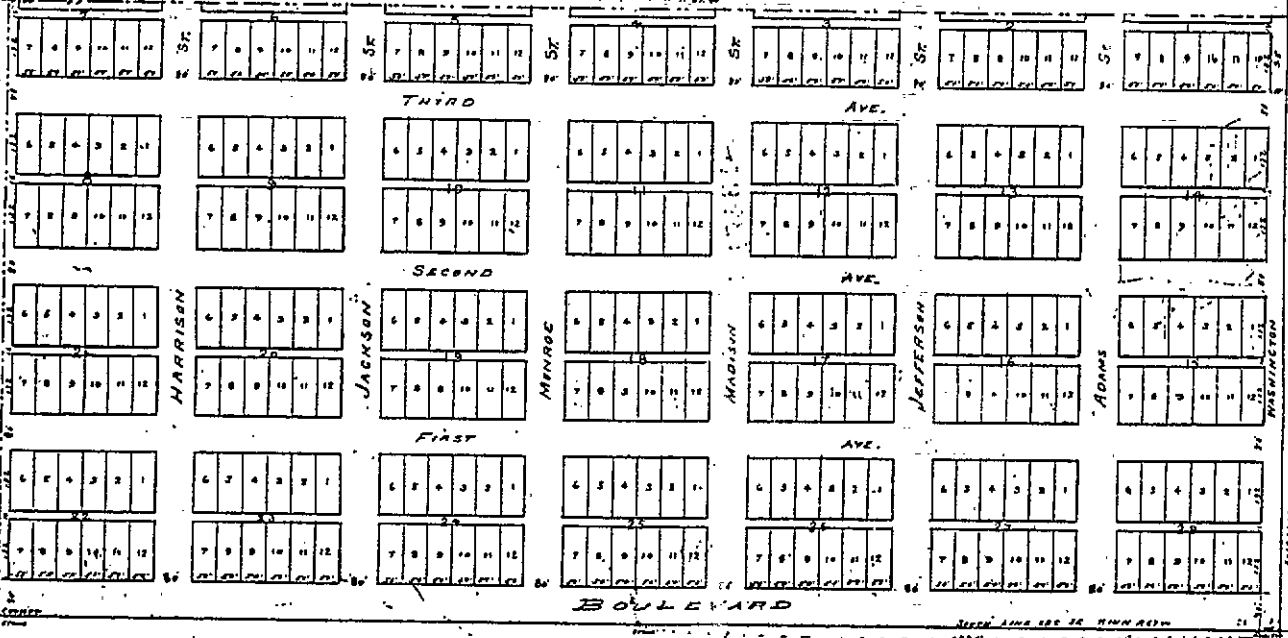

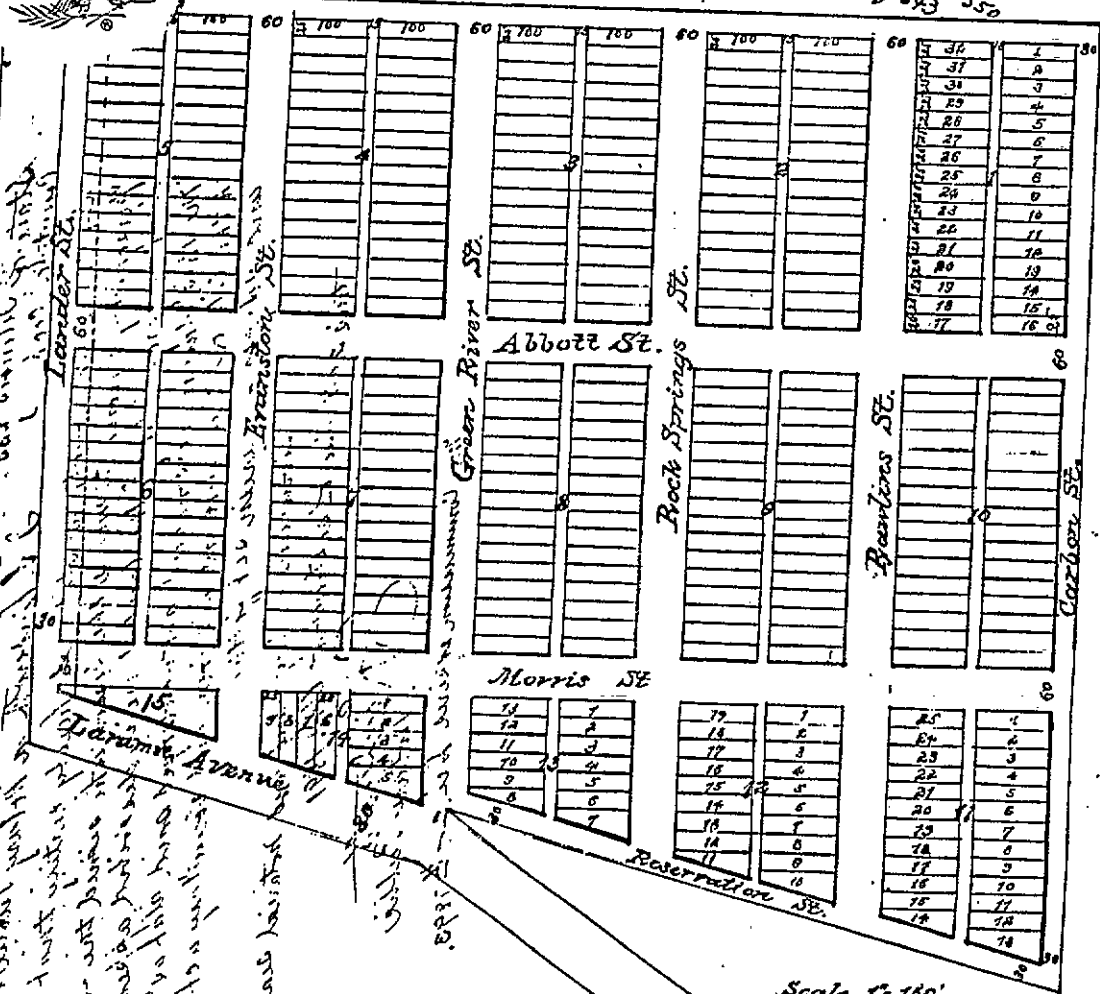

The foregoing subdivision of sections 23 & 24 Township 14 North of Range 67 West follows to-wit:

Lot (2) Two in section 24 Township 14 North of Range 67 West, also beginning at the corner stone at the north east corner of section 23, in Township 14 North, of Range 67 West, thence running westerly on the north line of said section 23 55 feet thence running southerly at right angles with the west said line to the northerly boundary line of the Fort. David (as Russell Military Reservation), thence running southeasterly along said line to the east line of said section, thence running northeasterly in a straight line to the place of beginning, making a strip of land 50 feet wide and extending from the north line of said section to the north line of said section, as appears on this plat is with free consent and approval of the undersigned owner and proprietor, and the streets and alleys therein shown have been dedicated perpetually to the public use.
