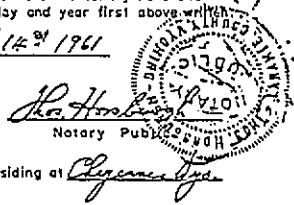

 I, T. H. Baldwin of Cheyenne, Wyoming, hereby certify that this plat of TERRY HOMESITES, 2nd Filing, was made from notes taken during an actual survey made under my direction in January, 1958; that it shows accurately the lots as marked on the ground by iron pipe set at each lot corner and that the land embraced in this subdivision is all that part of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 17 T. 13 N., Range 66 W., 6th P.M., Laramie County, Wyoming, containing 1.31 acres, more or less, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the West boundary of said NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4, a distance of 215 feet South of the NW corner of said NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4, thence N 89° 50' E, parallel to the North boundary of said NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4, a distance of 300.2 feet to a point; thence South 0° 18' E parallel to the West boundary of said NE 1/4 SW 1/4, a distance of 190 feet to a point; thence S 89° 50' West, parallel to the North boundary of said NE 1/4 SW 1/4, a distance of 300.2 feet to a point on the West boundary of said NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4; thence N. 0° 18' W along the West boundary of said NE 1/4 SW 1/4 a distance of 190 feet to the point of beginning.
