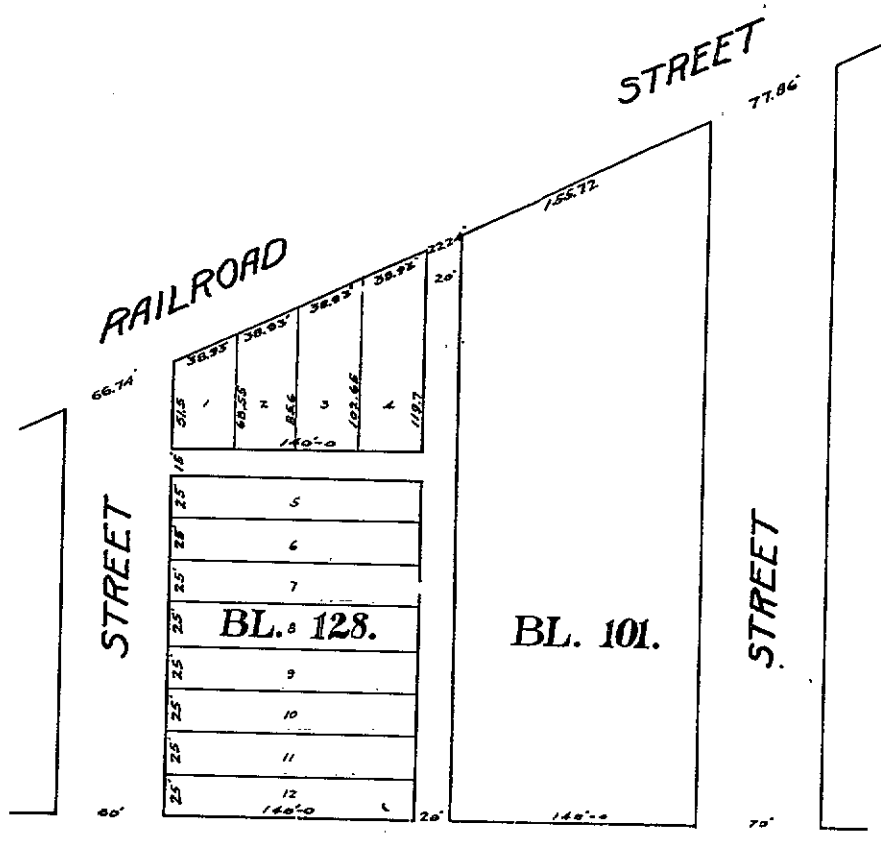

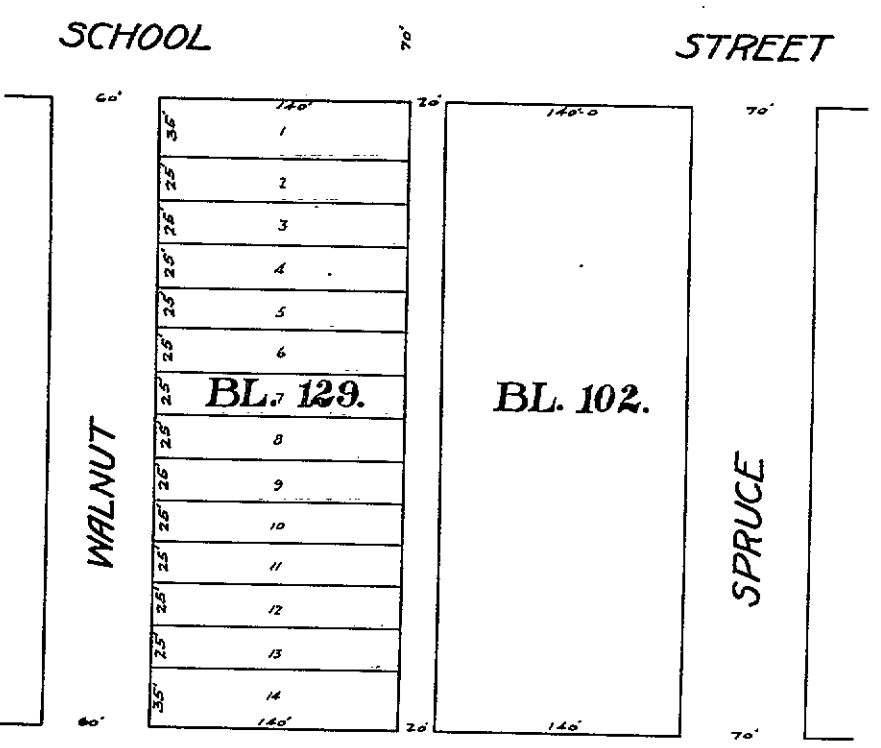
That said owner of said lands caused the same to be surveyed and platted by M. N. Wheeler, a licensed surveyor of the State of Wyoming
