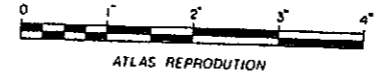

This is to certify that the subdivision shown hereon of parts of SW 1/4 NW 1/4 and NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 33 N., R. 73 W., and as appears on this plat and designated as parts of Blocks 148, 169, 170, 171 and 172, and all of Blocks 173, 200, 201, 202, and 206 to 210 inclusive, excepting Lot 10, Block 206, being an addition to the City of Casper, Natrona County, State of Wyoming, is with the free consent and in accordance with the desire of the undersigned owner and proprietor, and that the streets and alleys, and tracts shown hereon and designated "Public Parks", are hereby dedicated to the public use.

This plat and dedication are made, executed, acknowledged, delivered and filed in lieu of and for the purpose of correcting any and all errors, mistakes and omissions, in that certain plat and dedication made and executed and acknowledged and delivered by said J. M. Carey & Brother, a Wyoming corporation, on October 31st, 1922, and thereafter, on the 5th day of January, A.D. 1923, duly filed in the office of the county clerk and ex-officio register of deeds in and for the said County of Natrona, in the State of Wyoming, and there duly recorded in Book 35 of Warranty Deeds, on page 222.
