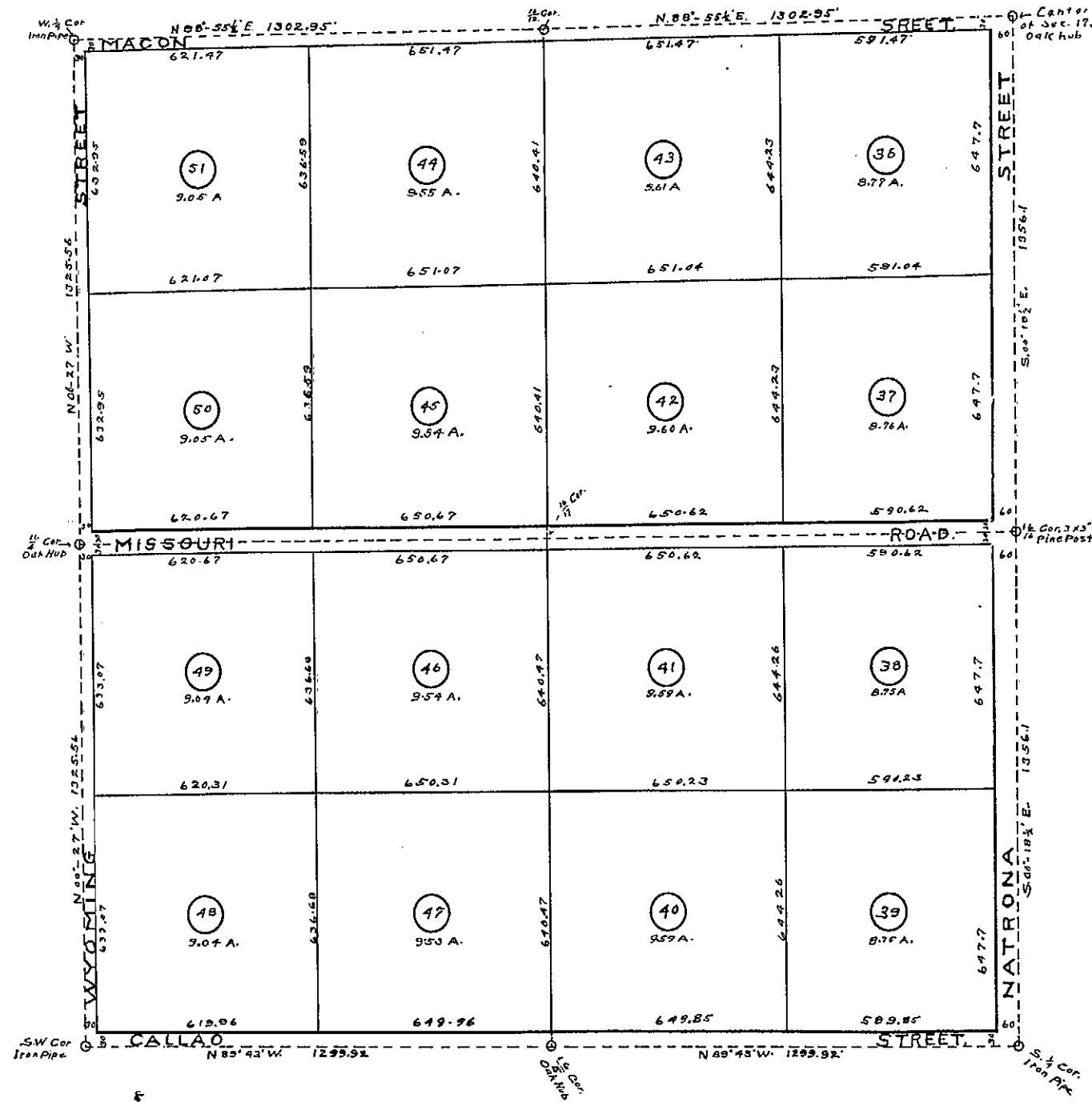


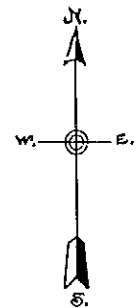

This is to certify that the above named subdivision of the Southwest One-Quarter (SW.4) of Section Seventeen (17) Township Thirty-four (34) North, Range Seventy-nine (79) West of the Sixth (6th) Principal Meridian, located in Natrona County State of Wyoming, as appears introduced and as LOTS numbered consecutively from Thirty-Six (36) to Fifty-One (51) both inclusive, said subdivision being known as "ENGLEWOOD NO. 2" is with the free consent and in accordance with the desires of the undersigned owners and Proprietors: John M. England and, Etta H. England his wife.

This is to certify that the survey and subdivision of "ENGLEWOOD NO. 2" as shown hereon and comprising the Southwest One-Quarter (SW.4) of Section Seventeen (17) Township Thirty-four (34) North, Range Seventy-nine (79) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian (6th PM.) was made by me during May A.D. 1923, at the request of John M. England. The survey was executed with a Gurley Transit and a 300 ft. Steel tape. Each lot corner is a 3'x3'x2' Pine Post set 10" in the ground, painted white, the appropriate lot number painted thereon in black. The Southeast and Northeast corners of the section are the original Government corners, the Southeast corner being a plain marked stone and the Northeast corner being four plain pits. All other corners were established according to the prescribed rules of the U.S. Land Office. All linear dimensions and all angles given on this plat were measured with care and are correct to the best of my knowledge and belief. Witness my hand and seal this 2nd day of May, A.D. 1923.
