This is to certify that the above named partial subdivision of the Northwest One-quarter of the Northeast One-quarter (N.W. 1/4 N.E. 1/4) of Section One (1), Township Thirty-three (33) North, Range Seventy-nine (79) West, of Sixth (6th) Principal Meridian, located in Natrona County, State of Wyoming, as appears on the annexed plat as Blocks numbered consecutively from Twenty-eight (28) to Thirty-two (32), both inclusive, each block containing Lots numbered consecutively from One (1) inclusive, said subdivision being known as EVANSVILLE ADDITION NO. 2 (Number Two), is with the free consent and in accordance with the desires of the undersigned owners and proprietors, William T. Evans and Wealthy S. Evans, his wife.
The parties hereto release and waive all rights under and by virtue of the homestead laws of the State of Wyoming.

This is to certify that the survey and subdivision of "Evansville Addition No. 2" as shown hereon, and comprising a part of the Northwest One-quarter of the Northeast One-quarter (N.W. 1/4 N.E. 1/4) of Section One (1), Township Thirty-three North (T. 33 N.), Range Seventy-nine West (R. 79 W.) of the Sixth Principal Meridian, was made by me during August, A.D. 1922, at the request of, and for, William T. Evans. The survey was executed with a Buff Transit and a 300' steel tape. Each block corner is marked with a 4"x4"x30" pine stake set 20" in the ground, tacked and painted white. The ends of the alleys in each block are marked with a 3"x3"x24" pine stake set 18" in the ground, tacked and painted white. Every lot corner is marked with a 2"x2"x16" pine stake set 12" in the ground, top painted white. The block numbers in black were painted on the 4"x4" block-corner posts, and the lot numbers were painted on all lot stakes bordering streets. The section corners and quarter corners used were the same as used in the previous plats of "Evansville", "Evansville Addition No. 1" and "Independent Addition", and all 1/4 Corners were determined according to the prescribed rules of the U.S. Land Office. All angles and linear measurements were made with care and to the best of my knowledge and belief are correct.
