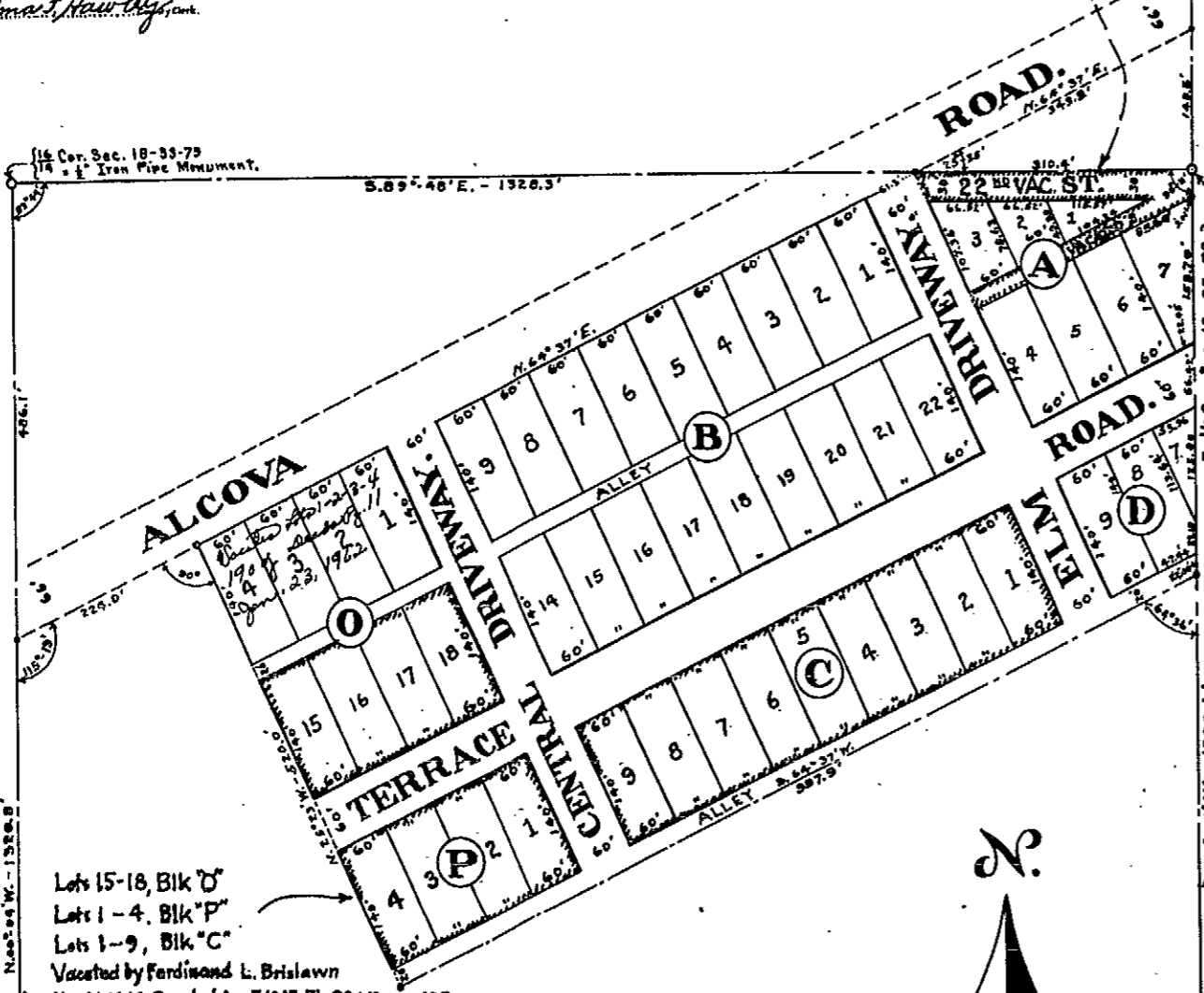

This is to certify that the above named subdivision of a part of the Northeast One-quarter of the Southeast One-quarter (N.E. 1/4 S.E. 1/4) of Section Eighteen (18), Township Thirty-three North (T. 33 N.), Range Seventy-nine West (R. 79 W.) of the Sixth Principal Meridian (6th P.M.), located in Natrona County, State of Wyoming, as appears on the annexed plat as Blocks designated by Letters A, B, C, D, O, and P; each block containing Lots as follows: Block A contains Lots numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7; Block B contains Lots numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21 & 22; Block C contains Lots numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 & 9; Block D contains Lots numbered 1, 2, 3 & 4; said subdivision being known as "JIMSVILLE"; is with the free consent and in accordance with the desires of the undersigned owners and proprietors, Harry H. Price, and Margaret Price, his wife.
All Streets, Roads, Driveways and alleys shown on the annexed plat are hereby dedicated to the Public, and the Parties hereto release and waive all rights under and by virtue of the homestead laws of the State of Wyoming.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE:

This is to certify that the survey and subdivision of "JIMSVILLE" as shown on the annexed plat, and comprising a part of the Northeast One-quarter of the Southeast One-quarter (N.E. 1/4 S.E. 1/4) of Section Eighteen (18), Township Thirty-three North (T. 33 N.), Range Seventy-nine West (R. 79 W.) of the Sixth Principal Meridian (6th P.M.), in Natrona County, State of Wyoming, was made by me during January, 1924, for and at the request of Harry H. Price, of Casper, Wyoming. The survey was executed with surveyor's standard transit and steel-tape. Each block-corner was marked by setting a 4"x30" post to within 10" of ground surface, lashed and painted white. All other lot corners are marked by 1/2"x17" oak stakes, driven to within 5" of ground surface. The northeast corner of this subdivision, which is the E. 1/4 Corner of said Section 18 is a mld. Gov't. stone in place. The other 16 corners shown were established by proper pro-ration methods of the U.S. Land Office.

The annexed plat forms a complete and accurate record of this survey and subdivision, which is divided into Blocks A, B, C, D, O & P; each block being divided into lots as shown, and as described in foregoing Dedication. All distances, line bearings and angles shown on the annexed plat were measured with care, and are correct as shown to the best of my knowledge and belief.
