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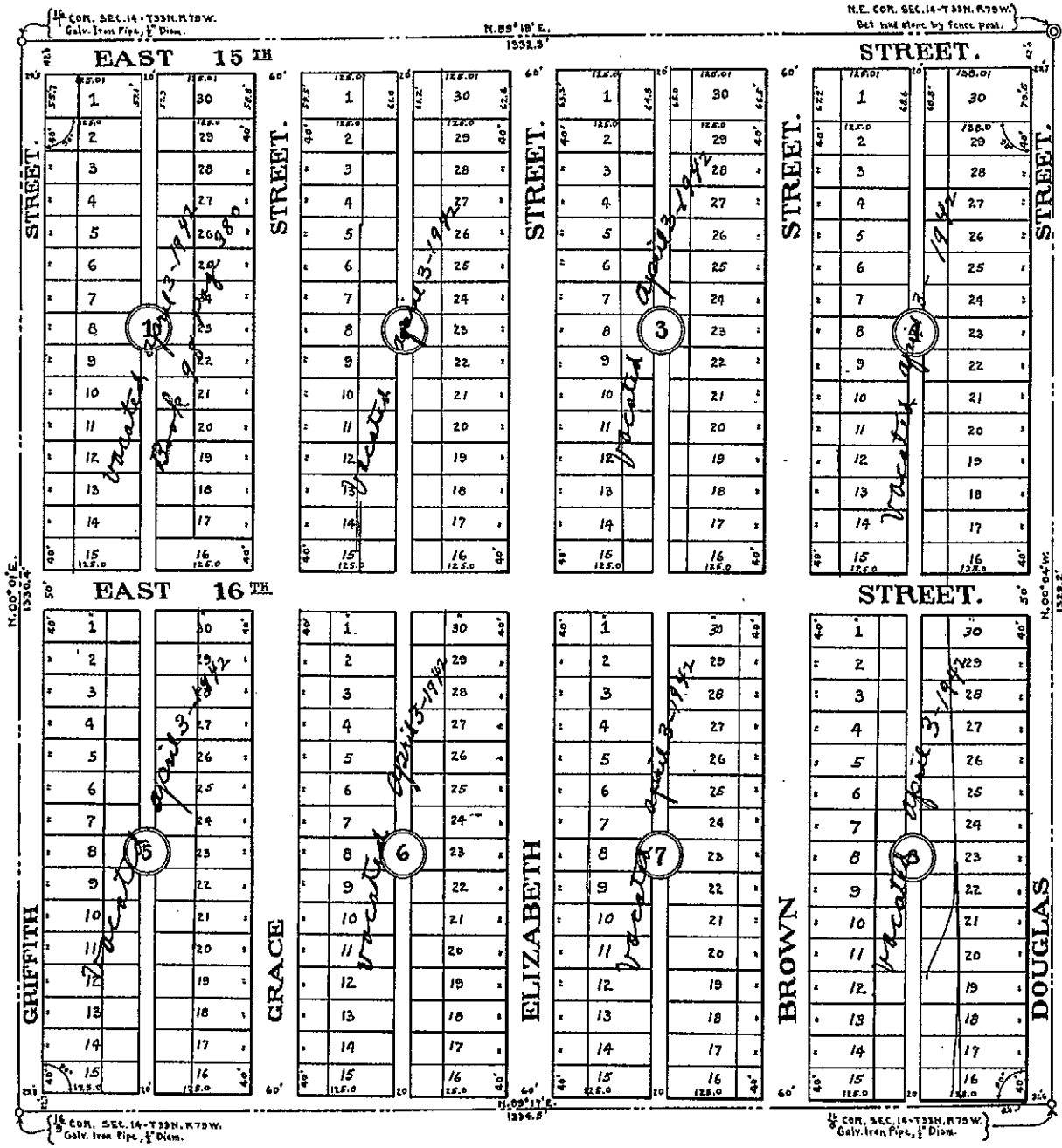
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# MAP OF JOHNSTONE ADDITION TO THE CITY OF CASPER.

This is to certify that the above named subdivision of the Northeast One-quarter of the Northeast One-quarter (N.E. 1/4 N.E. 1/4) of Section Fourteen (14), Township Thirty-three (33) North, Range Seventy-nine (79) West of the Sixth (6th) Principal Meridian, located in Natrona County, State of Wyoming, as appears on the annexed plat as Blocks numbered consecutively from One (1) to Eight (8), both inclusive, each block containing Lots numbered consecutively from One (1) to Thirty (30) both inclusive, said subdivision being known as "JOHNSTONE ADDITION TO THE CITY OF CASPER", is with the free consent and in accordance with the desires of the undersigned sole owner and proprietor, James B. Griffith, who hereby also releases and waives all rights under and by virtue of the Homestead Laws of the State of Wyoming pertaining to said tract of land.

This is to certify that the survey and subdivision of "JOHNSTONE ADDITION TO THE CITY OF CASPER" as shown on annexed plat and comprising the Northeast One-quarter of the Northeast One-quarter (N.E. 1/4 N.E. 1/4) of Section Fourteen (14), Township Thirty-three North (T. 33 N.), Range Seventy-nine West (R. 79 W.) of the Sixth (6th) Principal Meridian, was made by me during October 1922, at the request of and for James B. Griffith. The survey was executed with a Bull transit and a 300-foot steel tape.

Each block corner was marked on the ground by a 4 1/2" x 3" pine post set 20" in the ground, tacked, painted white, and the appropriate block number painted thereon in black. The ends of the alleys in each block were marked by 3" x 5" x 24" pine stakes, set 18" in the ground, tacked and painted white. All lot corners were marked by 1" x 1 1/2" x 16" oak stakes driven 12" in the ground, tops painted white. Those lot stakes bordering streets have the appropriate lot numbers painted thereon in black.

The section and quarter corners were the same as used in all previous plats (on record) of subdivisions within this Section (14), and the location of the 1/4 corners was made according to the prescribed rules of the U.S. Land Office. The 1/4 corners bounding this Subdivision are marked on the ground as shown on the annexed plat.

All linear and angular measurements shown on annexed plat were made with care and to the best of my knowledge and belief are correct.
