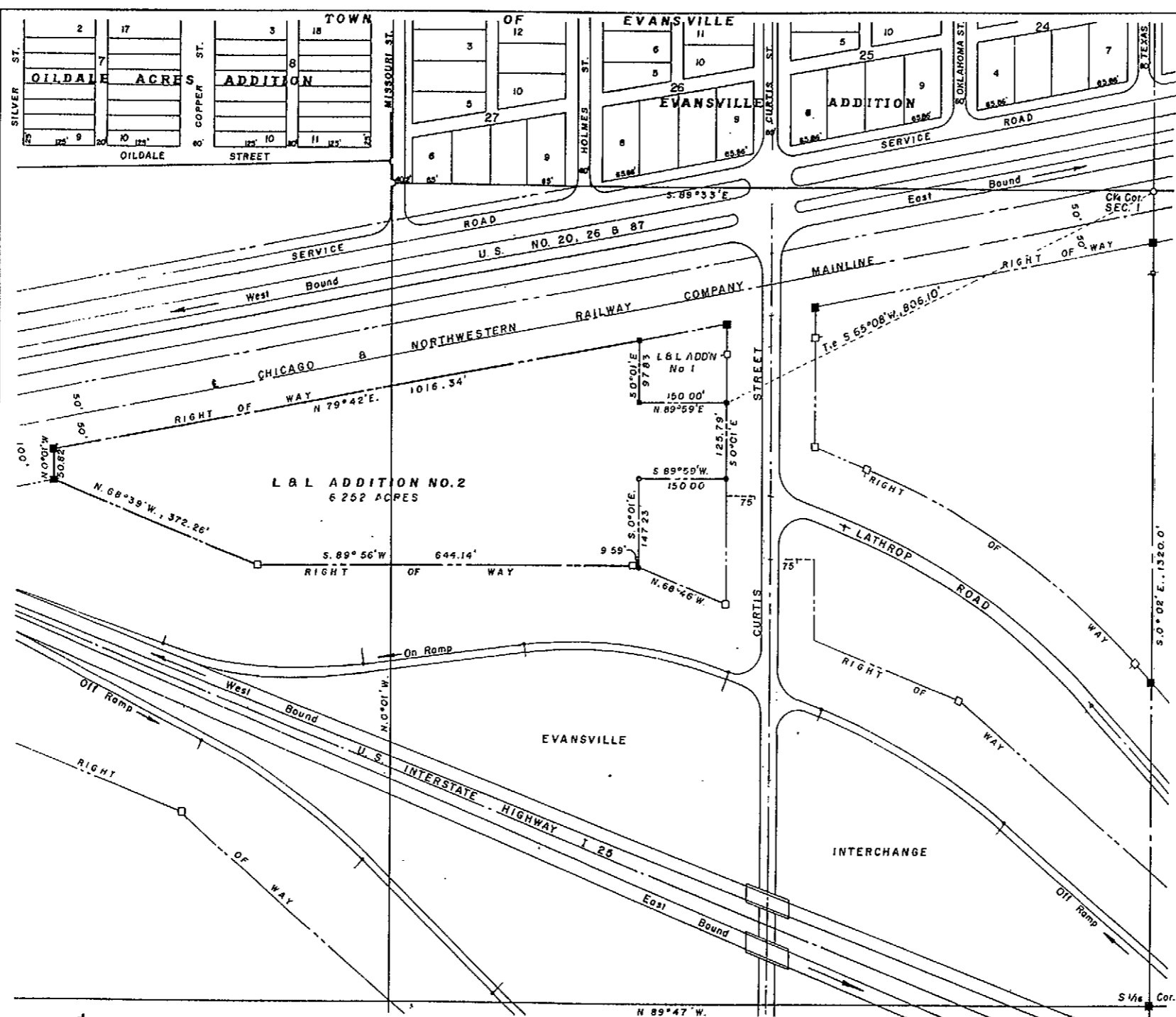

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

A Plat located in and being a portion of the N 1/2 SW 1/4, Section 1, T. 33 N., R. 79 W., of the 6th Principal Meridian, Wyoming and being more particularly described as follows:
 Beginning at a point which marks the southeast corner of "L & L Addition No. 1" to the Town of Evansville and is located in the westerly line of Curtis Street at S 65° 08' W, 806.10 feet from the northeast corner of said N 1/2 SW 1/4, Section 1.
 Thence from said corner and point of beginning and along the perimeter of said Addition No. 2, S 0° 01' E and along Curtis Street, 125.79 feet to a point, thence S 89° 59' W, 150.00 feet to a point; thence S 0° 01' E, 147.23 feet to a point in the northeasterly right of way line of U.S. Highway No. 1-25; thence along said right of way line, N 68° 46' W, 9.59 feet to a point; thence S 89° 56' W, 644.14 feet to a point; thence N 68° 39' W, 372.26 feet to a point in the southeasterly right of way line of the Chicago & Northwestern Railway Company, thence along said right of way N 0° 01' W, 50.82 feet to an angle point in said right of way line; thence along said right of way and parallel to the centerline of said Railway Company's Mainline Track as measured 50.00 feet southeasterly and perpendicular therefrom, N 79° 42' E, 1016.34 feet to a point and northwest corner of said Addition No. 1, thence along the westerly line thereof, S 0° 01' E, 97.83 feet to the southwest corner, thence N 89° 59' E, 150.00 feet to the point of beginning and containing 6.252 acres, more or less.

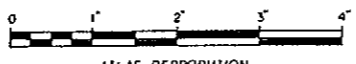
