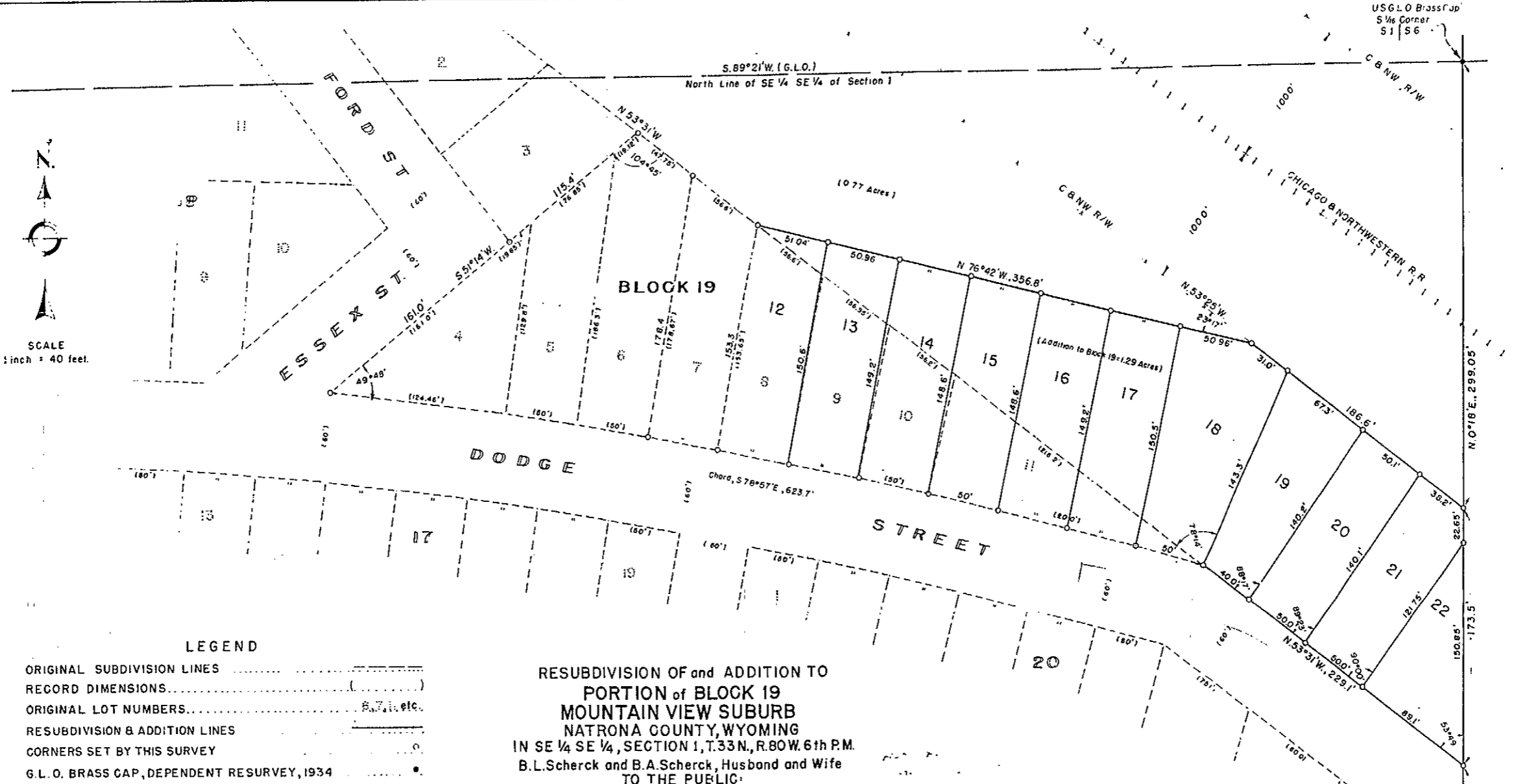

 We, H. L. Worthington and E. C. Lenhart, being duly licensed surveyors in the State of Wyoming, hereby certify that this survey of the Resubdivision of a Portion of Block 19, Mountain View Suburb was made by us after first re-establishing sufficient Block Corners to perform an accurate survey and that such corners as re-established conform to the Original Filing Plat of said Mountain View Suburb as recorded on Page 44, Book 19 of Deeds in the Office of the County Clerk, Natrona County, Wyoming. We further certify that all re-established and replotted block or lot corners as shown on this plat were marked by 1/2" x 14" iron pipe driven flush with the ground and properly identified.

We further certify that that certain portion of the Southeast one-quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 1, T.33 N., R.80 W., with Precor No. 100 in Natrona County, Wyoming lying north of a portion of Block 19 and Dodge Street as originally platted in Mountain View Suburb and south of the Southern Right-of-Way Line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad Tracks, as is more particularly set forth on this map, was surveyed by us and made to conform with the resubdivision of Block 19 and Addition thereto.

We being of this State, do hereby certify that the dimensions of the lots numbered 8 to 11 inclusive of this Block 19 as originally filed and established Lots numbered 12 to 22 inclusive as shown hereon, and dimensions thereon given in feet and decimals thereof, all lots have been accurately measured, checked off and properly identified to the best of our knowledge and belief.
