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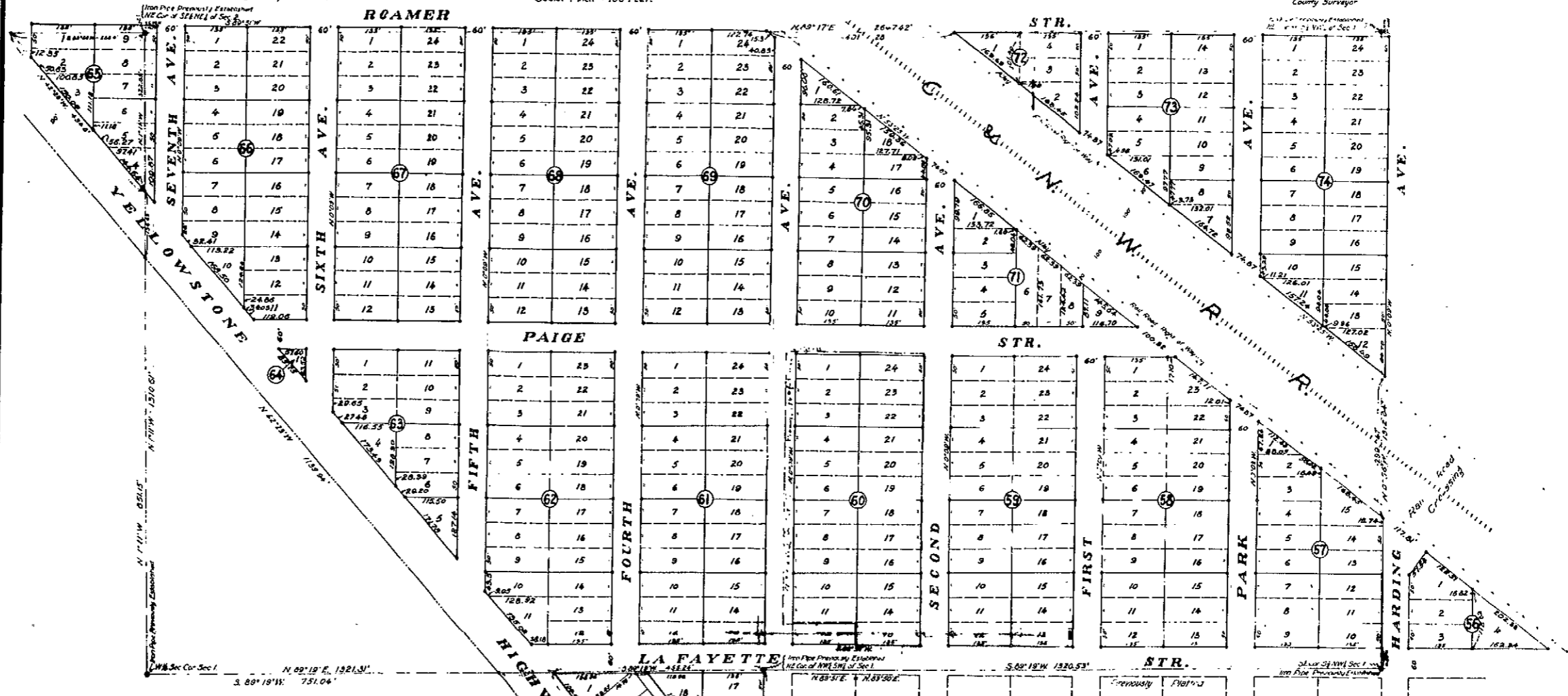

**ENGINEER'S CERTIFICATE.**

STATE OF WYOMING }  
County of Natrona }  
This is to certify that the survey and subdivision of Blocks Numbers: 55 to 74 both inclusive, all being an addition to MOUNTAIN VIEW SUBURB, and as shown on the annexed plat, comprising part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Two (2); part of the South Half of the Northeast Quarter (S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section One (1); part of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section One (1); and part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section One (1) all in Township Thirty-three North (33) Range Eighty West (80) of the Sixth Principal Meridian (6th PM), located in the County of Natrona, State of Wyoming, was made by me during February and March, A.D. 1924, for the MOUNTAIN VIEW DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, at the request of H.E. Grube and H.W. Baker, both of Casper, Wyoming.

The annexed plat shows the actual record and results of said survey and subdivision as indicated by the above named blocks and lots shown in said plat.

The survey was executed with a Kuffler & Esser standard transit No. 13376 and a one hundred foot Chicago steel tape. Each block corner was marked with a 4" x 4" pine post set 15" in the ground and painted white with the appropriate block and lot number painted in black upon it. All lot corners as indicated by circles on the plat were marked with locked 1" x 2" pine stakes driven 12" in the ground, painted white with the appropriate lot number painted in black upon it.

All section, quarter and 16th corners shown on said plat were previously established, recognized corners and were marked on the ground as shown on said plat.

All bearings, angles and distances as shown on the plat were measured in the field with care, checked by computations, and are correct as shown, to the best of my knowledge and belief.
