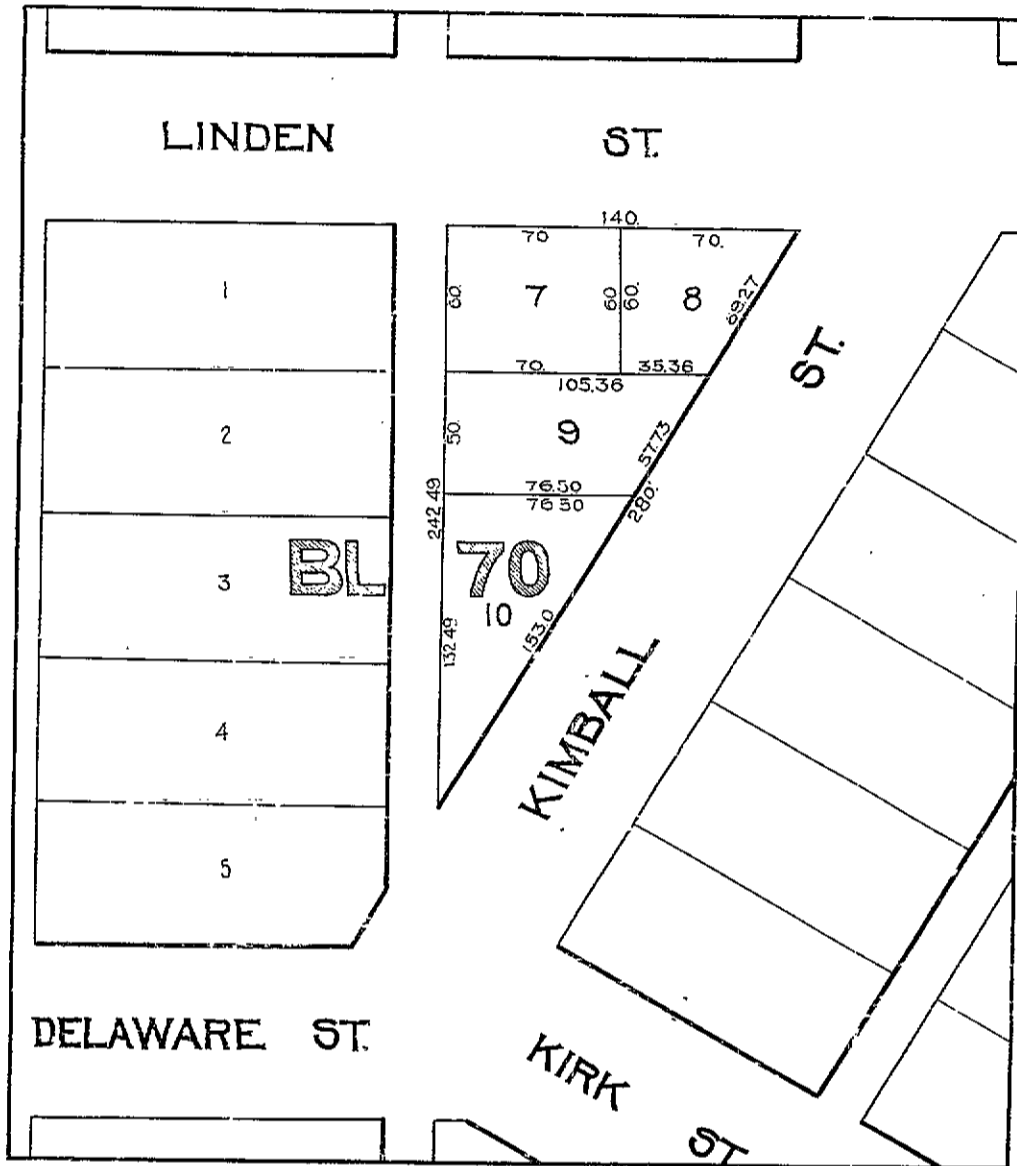

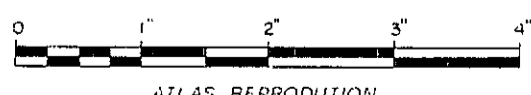
We, Harry E. Parsons and Christie V. Parsons, husband and wife, do hereby certify that we are the present and sole owners of Lot 6, Block 70, Town of Casper, Natrona County, State of Wyoming, situated in and being a part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 9, T. 33N. - R. 70W. 6<sup>th</sup> PM, which said tract is bounded and described as follows: - Beginning at a point 20 feet east of the northeast corner of Lot 1, Block 70, <sup>Town of Casper</sup> thence east along south line of Linden Street 140 feet, thence S30° 00' W. along the north line of Kim. all Street 280 feet, thence north along east line of alley in Block 70, 242.49 feet to the point of beginning; that the subdivision of said tract of land as the same appears upon this plat is with our free consent and in accordance with our desire, and that said subdivision shall be known as "Parsons' Sub-division of Lot 6 Block 70" in the City of Casper, Natrona County, Wyoming.
