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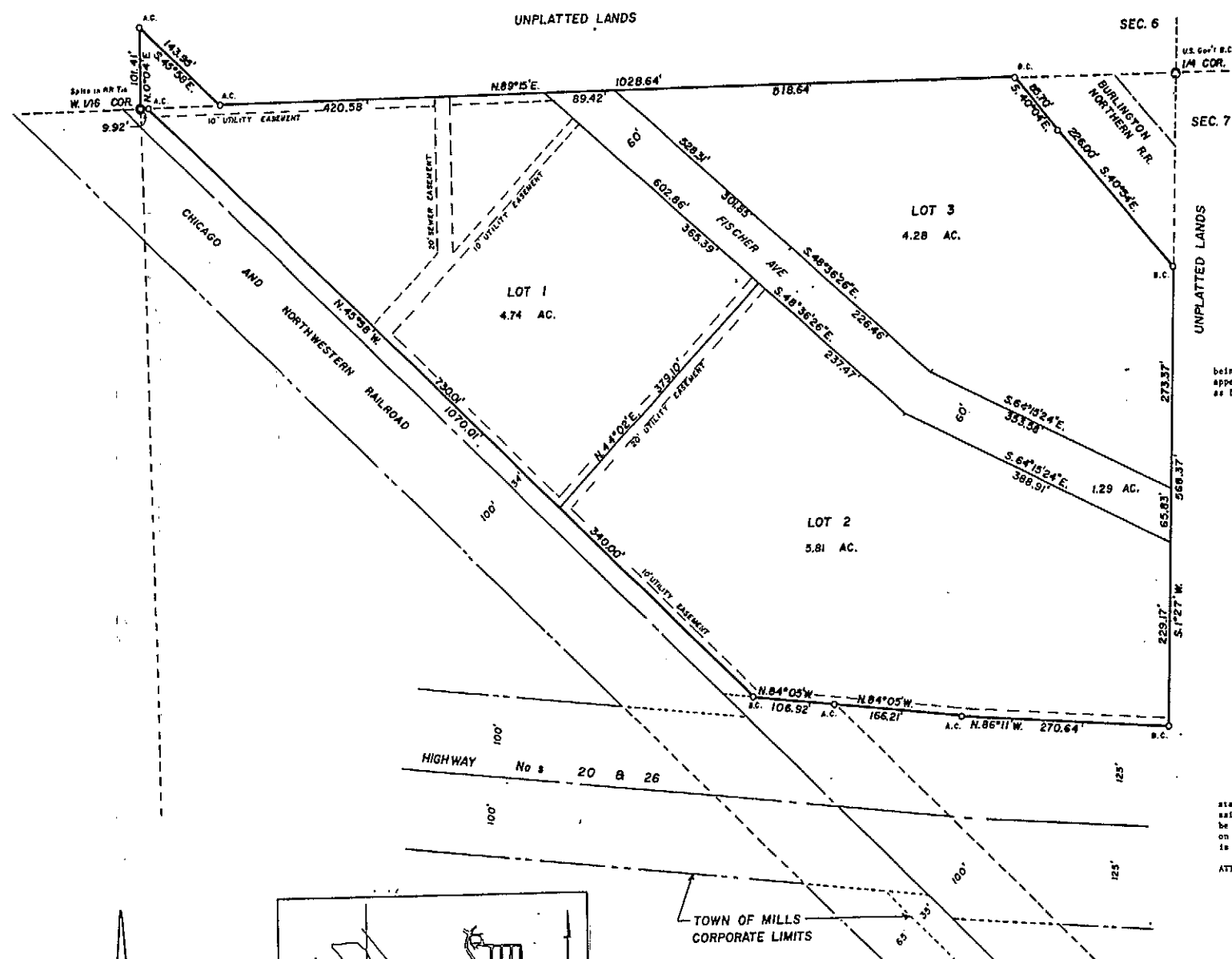
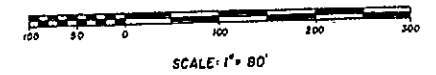

CERTIFICATE OF DEDICATION

The undersigned PETRO-CHEM, INC., a corporation of Billings, Montana, being owner and proprietor of the above and foregoing Subdivision as it appears on this Plat and more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

Beginning at the west 1/16 corner common to Sections 6 and 7, Township 33 North, Range 79 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Natrona County, Wyoming, being the true Point of Beginning; thence along the west line of the SE 1/4 of said Section 6, N. 0° 04' E., a distance of 101.41 feet to a point; thence S. 45° 58' E., a distance of 143.95 feet to a point in the north line of said Section 7; thence N. 82° 15' E., along said north line and along the north line of the tract herein being described, a distance of 1028.64 feet to a point in the southerly right-of-way line of the Burlington-Northern Railroad; thence S. 40° 04' E., along said right-of-way line and the northeast side of said tract 85.70 feet to a point; thence S. 40° 54' E., continuing along said right-of-way line and the northeast side of said tract 226.00 feet to a point in the north-south centerline of said Section 7; thence S. 1° 27' W., along said centerline, being the westerly line of said tract, 348.37 feet to a point in the northerly right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 20 & 26; thence N. 84° 11' W., along said northerly right-of-way line, being the southerly line of said tract, 270.64 feet to a point; thence N. 84° 05' W., continuing along said northerly highway right-of-way line, and said southerly line of said tract, 166.21 feet to a point, being the intersection of the said northerly right-of-way line of said highway and the northerly right-of-way line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad; thence continuing N. 84° 05' W., along said highway right-of-way line, said northeasterly right-of-way line of said Railroad, and the southerly line of said tract, 106.92 feet to a point, being the southwest corner of said tract and the intersection of the northeasterly right-of-way line of said Chicago and Northwestern Railroad and the said northerly right-of-way line of said highway; thence N. 45° 58' W., along the northeasterly right-of-way line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad, and the west line of said tract, 1010.01 feet to a point on the north line of Section 7; thence S. 89° 15' W., along the line common to Sections 6 and 7, a distance of 9.92 feet to the west 1/16th corner common to Section 6 and 7, being the true Point of Beginning; the Subdivision area described containing 16.12 acres, more or less;

states that it is with the free consent and in accordance with the desires of said Owner and Proprietor of said lands. The name of said Subdivision shall be PETRO-CHEM ADDITION to the Town of Mills, Wyoming. Any easements shown on the Plat are conceded and reserved as such. The 60-foot roadway as shown is dedicated to the use of the Public.

CERTIFICATE OF SURVEYOR

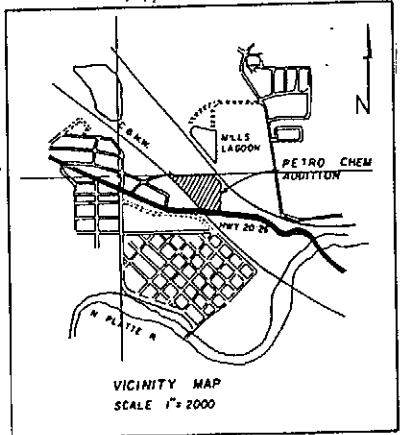
