

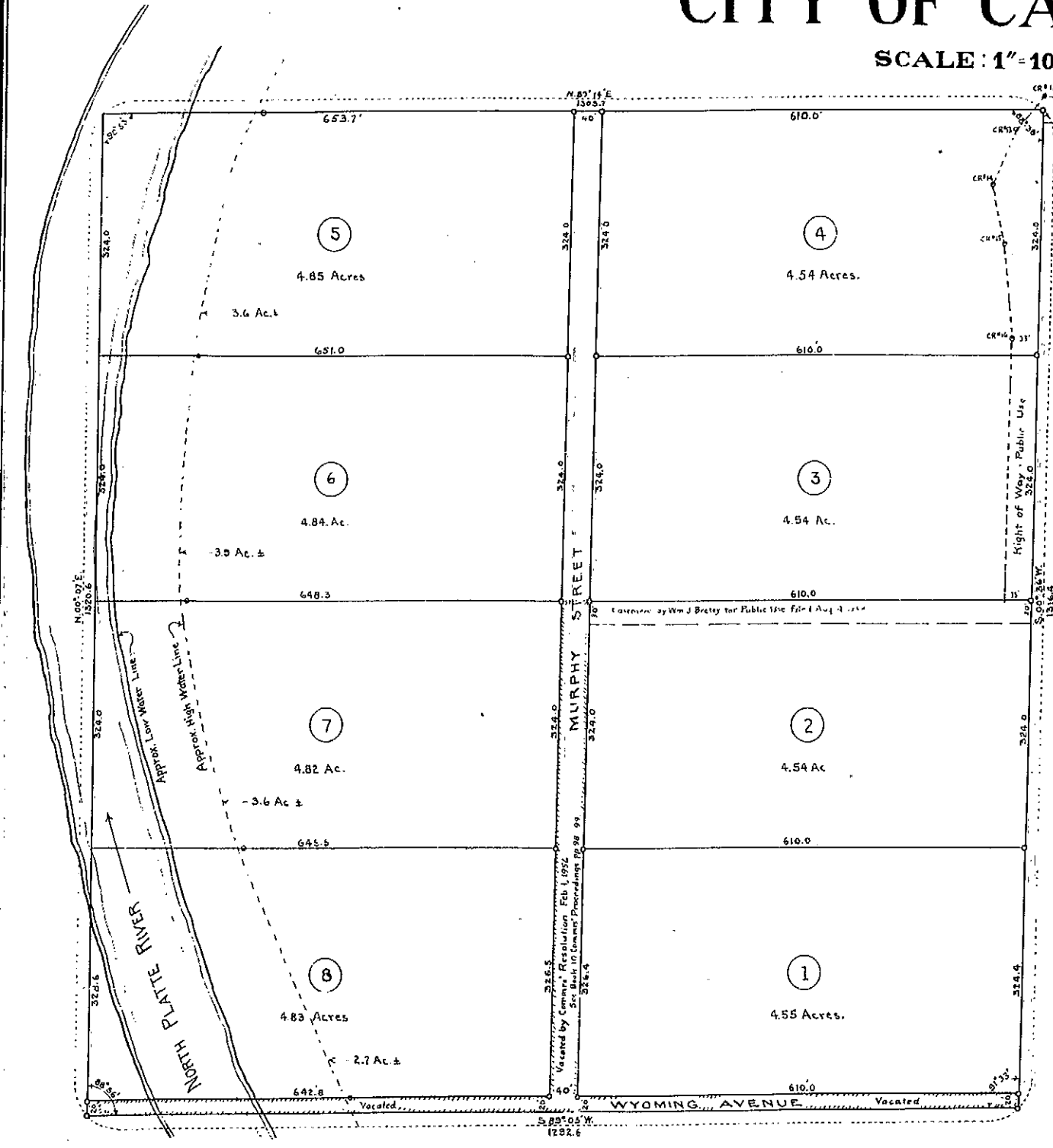

DESCRIPTION OF LAND.
The land embraced in the annexed plat is described as the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 33 North, Range 80 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, or more specifically as follows: Starting at the S.W. Corner of said NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 14 which is the point of beginning; proceeding thence N. 00° 07' E., a distance of 1320.6 feet to a point; proceeding thence N. 89° 14' E., a distance of 1303.7 feet to a point; proceeding thence S. 00° 36' W., a distance of 1316.4 feet to a point; and proceeding thence S. 89° 03' W., a distance of 1292.6 feet to said point of beginning; comprising a tract of approximately 39.29 Acres.

I, Wilbur H. Fisher, of Casper, Natrona County, a duly licensed Engineer in the State of Wyoming, being first duly sworn, upon my oath do depose and say:-
That I made the survey of the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 14, Twp. 33 N., R. 80 W. of the 6th P.M., as per the above described metes and bounds, at the request of Mr. Frank A. Murphy, owner and proprietor of the land.
That I subdivided the land into lots and streets as shown by the annexed plat, which is a true and correct representation of the survey.
That at all points shown on the plat thus, (o), a piece of galvanized iron pipe 15" long by 3/4" diameter was driven in the ground to mark said points, with exception of the S.W., S.E., and N.E. corners of the tract which are marked by pieces of galvanized iron pipe 18" long and 1" diameter.
