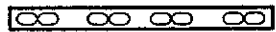

All streets and alleys shown on annexed plat are hereby dedicated to the public use. I, Albert Park of Casper, Wyoming, hereby certify that the survey and subdivision of "WEST CREST" as appears on the annexed plat, and comprising a part of the West One-half of the Northeast One-quarter W 1/2 NE 1/4 and a part of the Northeast One-quarter NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section Thirty-four (34), Township Thirty-four North (T34N), Range Eighty West (R80W) of the Sixth Principal Meridian (6th P.M.) located in County of Natrona, State of Wyoming, was made by me during the month of April, A.D. 1924, at the request of and for Western Realty and Lumber Company, by F.M. Zimmers, its president.  
The survey was executed with surveyors standard Gunter transit and 300-foot Chicago steel tape. Every block corner was marked on the ground with a 3/4" iron pin, 24" long, driven 20" in the ground.  
All lot corners along streets, all alley ends, and corners of irregular lots, were marked with 3/8" round iron pins, 12" long, driven 10" in the ground.  
All line and quarter section corners were established by prescribed rules of the U.S. Land Office, from known government monuments, all distances and bearings were measured with care and are correct as shown on annexed plat, to the best knowledge and belief.
