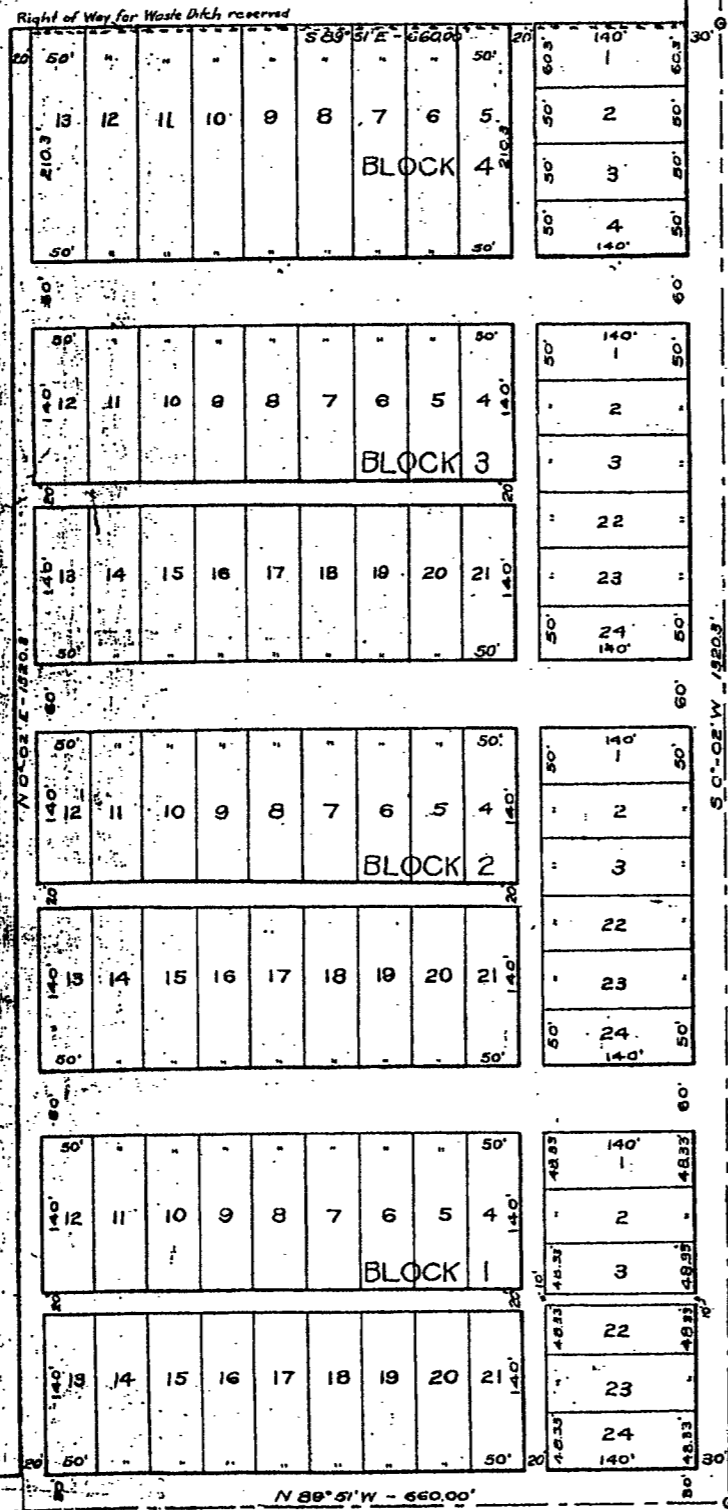


PLAT OF
 DEMINGS ADDITION

The above and foregoing subdivision of the E½ of the SW¼ of the SE¼ of Lot 75, Township 55 North, Range 99 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, in Park County, Wyoming, known and designated as Demings Addition, an addition to the Town of Powell, Wyoming, as appears on this plat, is with the free consent and in accordance with the desires of the undersigned owners and proprietors, including the release and waiver of the right of homestead. The streets and alleys shown hereon are dedicated to the public use and benefit, and the water right appurtenant to the said platted lands shall be and remain appurtenant to the town lots as platted hereon. Right of way for ditches, canals and waste water, upon the streets and alleys, for the proper irrigation of the said lots is hereby reserved for the use and benefit of the entire addition.

Howard F. Bell, being first duly sworn according to law, deposes and says that the foregoing map is an accurate representation of a survey made by him on February 13 and 14, 1913, of Demings Addition to the Town of Powell, Wyoming, being the E½ of the SW¼ of the SE¼ of Lot 75, Township 55 North, Range 99 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, in Park County, Wyoming, and further described and bounded as follows: Beginning at the 1/4 cor. which marks the NE cor. of the above mentioned tract; thence 50° 02' W 1320.3' to the 1/4 cor. which marks the SE cor. of said tract; thence N 89° 51' W 660.0' thence N 0° 02' E 1320.3'; thence S 89° 51' E 660.0' to the place of beginning, containing 20.00 acres.
