

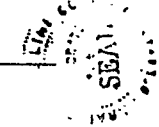
**DEDICATION**

Know all men by these presents, that Marathon Pipe Line Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, authorized to do business in the State of Wyoming, owner in fee simple of the lands embraced in this plat and description of MARATHON PIPE LINE SUBDIVISION of Lots A, B, and C, Block 128, Original Townsite of Powell, Park County, Wyoming, and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of said Block 128 and thence proceeding S89°58'E along the south line of Block 128 a distance of 380.6 feet, thence N25°33'30"W a distance of 522.14 feet to a point on the north line of Block 128, thence S67°34'30"W a distance of 232.46 feet, thence S0°02'W along a line parallel to the west line of Block 128 a distance of 382.0 feet, thence S89°58'E a distance of 40.0 feet, thence N0°02'E a distance of 145.0 feet, thence S89°58'E a distance of 20.0 feet to a point on the west line of Block 128, thence S0°02'W a distance of 145.0 feet to the point of beginning, containing 3.21 acres, more or less, does hereby declare the subdivision of said land to be its free act and deed and in accordance with its desires, and does hereby dedicate to the use of the public forever the alley shown within the MARATHON PIPE LINE SUBDIVISION, and by its Board of Directors, the Vice President, and Secretary have been authorized to execute this dedication in behalf of said Marathon Pipe Line Company.

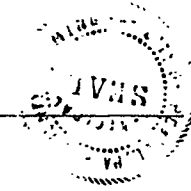

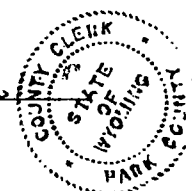

MARATHON PIPE LINE SUBDIVISION**

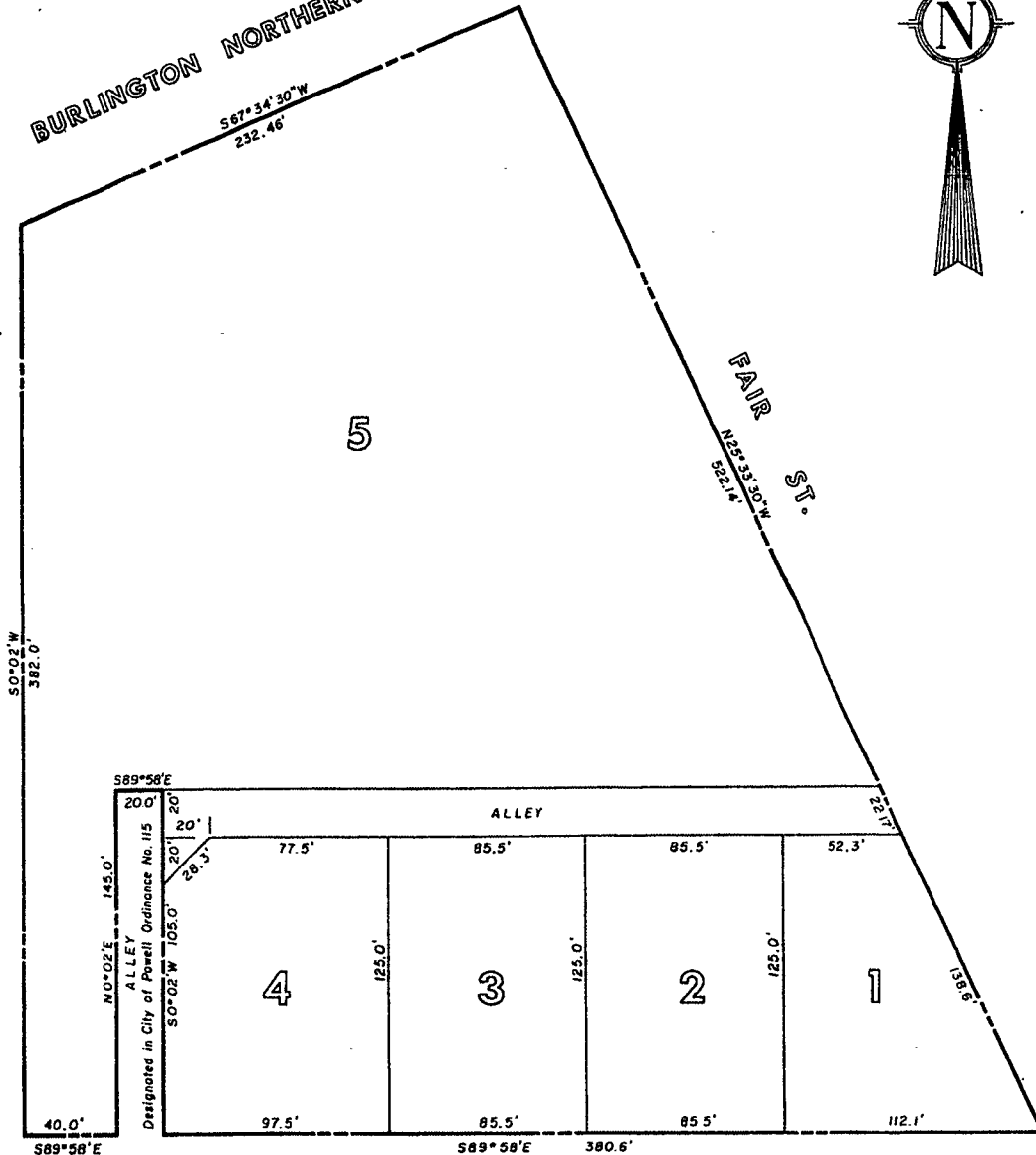

**ENGINEER'S CERTIFICATE**

I, Sidney J. Gros, of Casper, Wyoming, hereby certify that the above plat of MARATHON PIPE LINE SUBDIVISION, a subdivision of Block 128, Original Townsite of Powell, Park County, Wyoming, was made from notes taken during an actual survey made under my direction during October, 1970, and that said plat correctly and accurately shows the results of that survey; that said subdivision is described in the owner's Certificate of Dedication. Lot and Block corners are marked with iron pins and all dimensions are given in feet and decimals of feet.
