 2. PRIORITY DATE OF WATER RIGHT = APRIL 9, 1907.
 3. NUMBER OF ACRES ORIGINALLY PERMITTED = 80.00 ACRES ($N^{\circ}46'5^{\circ}20'$) = 1.143 C.F.S. 6.332 ACRES = .090 C.F.S.
 4. APPROPRIATION FROM BIG CREEK DITCH, TRIBUTARY OF BIG CREEK, TRIBUTARY OF NORTH PARK SHOSHONE RIVER, TRIBUTARY OF BIG HORN RIVER.
 5. TRADITIONALLY IRRIGATION HAS BEEN MADE BY COUNTY AND THE IRRIGATION EASEMENT ACROSS THE UNLAWY PART OF LOT #1 SHALL ALWAYS BE MADE TO LOT #1 FOR COUNTY IRRIGATION.
 6. LOT OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DRAINAGE OF THEIR IRRIGATION WATER AND ALL RETURN FLOW FOR THE IRRIGATION OF LOTS #1 AND #2 IS TO DRAIN INTO HALF MILE CREEK.
 7. WYOMING LAW DOES NOT RECOGNIZE ANY RIparian WATER RIGHTS. LOT OWNERS HAVE NO RIGHT TO IRRIGATION WATER FLOWING PAST OR THROUGH THE SUBDIVISION OTHER THAN THAT WHICH IS SPECIFICALLY ADJUCATED OR APPROPRIATED TO THEIR LOT VIA THE STATE ENGINEERS OFFICE OR THE STATE BOARD OF CONTROL.
