Any surplus or deficiency is distributed uniformly, in proportion to the dimensions shown on the plat. Each lot bears its respective number and area.

Stingley, husband and wife, are the owners of a tract of land, shown on this plat as a part of the "Stingley Subdivision," near Powell, Wyoming, in Lot 51-P, and 51-I, Resurvey, in Township 55 North, Range 99 West, of the Sixth Principal Meridian, in Park County, Wyoming, and which may be more particularly described as follows:

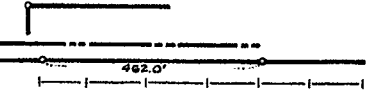
