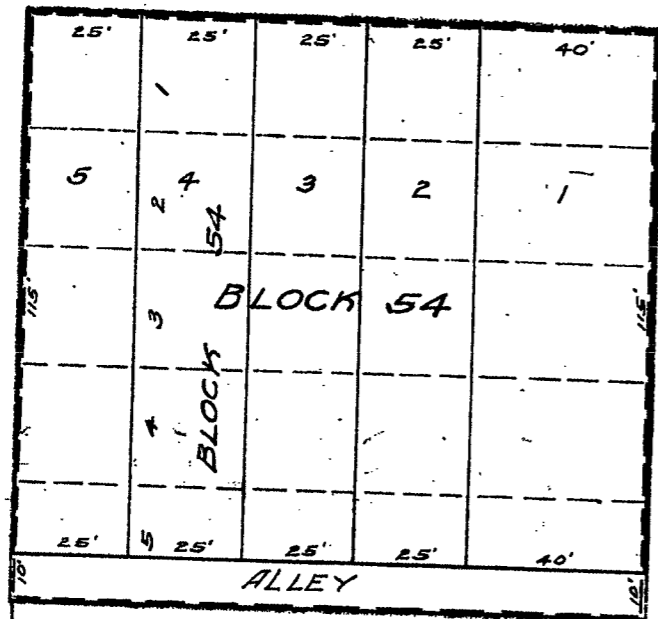


PLAT OF WAINSCOTT AND MARKS SUBDIVISION
